Training times

For regular training we start at 10am and finish at 11am (for U5 and U6) or at 11.30 to 12pm (other age groups).

Festivals times vary but typically run 10am to 1pm.

Parking

We have plenty of parking on site but if we are full you can park...

- On the roads around Desborough Island (but please get as tight to the edge as you can)
- In the car park by Walton Bridge.

For festivals we charge a fee of £5 per car for visiting clubs.

Refreshments

We have a tea room selling hot and cold drinks and hot snacks including bacon and egg sandwiches. The bar opens at 12pm.

Kit shop

The kit shop is open most Sundays from 9.30. If the shop is shut then the bar sells mouth guards and has hot water to fit them. We also have a boot swap – always worth looking for bargains.

Dogs

Dogs are welcome at Vandals but must always be kept on leads. When they need a walk, there is a path round the edge of the island and some common land just beyond Vandals pitches away from the car park.

They are not allowed in the tea-room at any time and access to the bar is limited at busy times.

Directions

We are right next to Walton Bridge.

From M25

Exit M25 at Junction 11 (A317/A320). At the top of the slip road, take the roundabout exit - A317 towards Weybridge. Follow the dual carriage way for 1 mile. At the roundabout take the 3rd exit signposted Weybridge. Go straight over the next two small roundabouts. At the mini roundabout directly in front of the church bear left into Weybridge High Street. Just past The Ship hotel and war memorial (on your left) turn left into Thames Street (speed humps). This becomes Walton Lane passing the Crown Pub on your left. Follow this road for 1¼ miles with Thames on your left. At the top of the small hill turn left over the small bridge. Keep the Thames on your right. Follow the narrow lane for 400 metres into the club grounds

From A3

Leave the A3 at Painshill - signposted Cobham. At the roundabout, if coming from the north take the 3rd exit, from the south take the 1st exit, onto a short dual carriageway which bears quite sharply to the left. After 200 meters turn right at the traffic lights into Seven Hills Road. Follow this road for 1½ miles continuing over a small roundabout. At the major roundabout take the first exit towards Weybridge (Queens road). After 1¼ miles with a cricket green on your left, turn right at the first roundabout then immediately left at the second roundabout. At the bottom of the hill at the war memorial turn right into Thames Street (speed humps). This becomes Walton Lane passing the Crown Pub on your left. Follow this road for 1¼ miles with Thames on your left. At the top of the small hill turn left over the small bridge. Keep the Thames on your right. Follow the narrow lane for 400 metres into the club grounds.

From M3 / A316

Follow the A316 (west bound) or the M3 (east bound). Exit at Sunbury on Thames. At Sunbury Cross round about, if coming from London take 3rd exit or from the south take 6th exit into Green Street. (2nd / 5th exit is into a train station). Go over the narrow humpback bridge and follow Green street for 1 mile. At the river Thames turn right. At Marshall's Roundabout (Texaco petrol station) take 1st exit. Halfway across Walton Bridge, turn right along the river bank towards Weybridge. After ¼ mile, turn right over the bridge. Keep the Thames on your right. Follow narrow lane for 400 metres into the club grounds
