## Club Photographic Policy

We encourage parents and spectators to take photographs to celebrate and promote the ethos and spirit of rugby within our club, however to protect our young members and players, in this digital age, we hope for acknowledgement and respect of these key points as set out by the RFU:

1. Personal information affiliated to a child or young person should never be used against a photograph or image, unless expressed permission is given by the child's parent or legal guardian;
2. Photographs should be of the activity or team, not individuals;
3. Our club registration process will request the permission from parents to allow photographs to be taken of their children at both home and away fixtures;
4. Children will be appropriately dressed when being photographed, photography will never be allowed in the changing rooms/showers;
5. Parents should be made aware of any filming or photography that is taken and used as a coaching aid. This footage will be carefully monitored and stored/destroyed appropriately by the coaching team;
6. All parents should be made aware that they should register an early interest of their intention or wish to take photographs;
7. We request that permission is sought from both home and away team managers for confirmation that the taking of photographs or film is permitted and fully consented by the parents and coaching teams;
8. Our club is private property and those not abiding or respecting this policy may be asked to leave;
9. Our teams will fully respect the photographic policies of opposing teams, in the absence of such a policy in other clubs, we will observe the regulations stipulated within our own document

2. Provide a clear brief about what is considered appropriate in terms of content and behaviour;
3. Inform them of the Club's commitment to safeguarding children. Establish who will hold the recorded images and what they intend to do with them;
4. Issue the professional photographer with identification, which must be worn at all times.
