

Senior Player Award Scheme

Application Form

Current and ex-players are invited to apply for a tie or cap that recognises their effort and number of appearances for a senior team at St Austell Rugby Club. Those entitled to an award must have played for the 1st, 2nd or 3rd XV or Veterans.

The qualifying levels of recognition and subsequent award are as follows:

- Less than 50 appearances New Senior tie;
- **50+ appearances** New Senior tie with '50' under the club crest;
- 100+ appearances New Senior tie with '100' under the club crest;
- **150+ appearances** New Senior tie with '150' under the club crest;
- **200+ appearances** Honours Cap with name on peak and '200' under it and a new Senior tie with '200' under the club crest;

We want our qualifying ex-players to be proud of their achievements and to wear these ties at Tregorrick Park with pride. We want our current and future players to strive to achieve the highest award possible whilst enjoying their rugby at St Austell Rugby Club.

The Caps and ties will be subsidised. This has been made possible through fund raising in memory of former player Tony 'Ginge' Marshall. We ask for a minimum donation of £6 for a tie and £30 for a cap. These figures do not cover the whole cost of those items, this is where the Ginge fund steps in to reduce the cost to the club and you.
