CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

The 2017 season was such a progressive year both on and off the field. The 1st XI managed to maintain their place in division 2, having gained promotion in 2016, even though several key players were not available through injury or moving away from the area. The growth of the youth coaching has continued. The club started this in 2008 with a handful of youths, in 2014 the U11's and U13's entered a cricket league for the first time. This is a tremendous achievement in such a short space of time and credit to Paul Waters, the coaches and helpers, who put in so much time and effort with the youngsters. I and the club thank you.

Moving forward the clubhouse is the main priority. We now have a building committee which has taken great steps forward in delivering plans for a structure that is fit for purpose, can accommodate our growing numbers and one that sits comfortably in the environment. They have engaged with the Thorley parish council, who are supportive in what we are trying to achieve, met with planners and are moving forward at a pace. To support this project fundraising has been vital and will continue in 2018. Quiz nights, Club Day (sponsored by MCD Interiors), and fireworks night generated great income along with a club sponsorship with Pestell & Co Letting & Estate Agent.

There are a group of people at the club who put in lots of hours to keep everything going to whom we all owe a great deal of thanks. From fixtures to accounts, groundwork to planning, arranging teams to providing refreshments and without whom the club would not function as it does. In saying that more hands make light work and I would encourage all who can help out to do so.

I have highlighted the importance of the youth players and their development to progress the club, but just as vital are the golden oldies who are still enjoying their cricket through the Thorley experience. Their knowledge, enthusiasm and commitment is a credit to see and they always play their cricket in the spirit it should be played.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR MEMBERS. PLAYERS & GUESTS

All Members. Players and Guests of Thorley Cricket Club will:

respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person within the context of cricket,

treat everyone equally and not discriminate on the grounds of age, gender, disability, race, ethnic origin, nationality, colour, parental or marital status, religious belief, class or social background, sexual preference or political belief,

not condone, or allow to go unchallenged, any form of discrimination, if witnessed, display high standards of behaviour,

promote the positive aspects of cricket, that is Fair Play,

encourage all participants to learn the Laws of Cricket and the match playing regulations and play within them, respecting the decisions of Match Officials,

actively discourage unfair play, Law or Regulation violations and arguing with Match Officials.

recognise good performance not just match results,

place the well being and safety of Young People above the development of performance.

ensure that activities are appropriate for the age, maturity, experience. of the individual.

respect Young People's opinions when making decisions about their participation in Cricket.

not smoke, drink alcohol or use banned substances whilst actively working with Young People at the Club,

not provide Young People with alcohol, cigarettes or banned substances when they are under the care of the Club.

follow the guidelines set out in the ECB document "Safe Hands" - Cricket's Policy for Safeguarding Children,

report any concerns in relation to the welfare of a Young Person, following the ECB reporting procedure, to the Club Child Welfare Officer.

In addition to the above All Club Officers and Appointed Volunteers working with Young People will:

hold relevant and appropriate qualifications, be covered by appropriate insurance, always work in an open environment - that is no private or unobserved situations, inform Young Players and Parents/Guardians of the requirements of participation in Cricket.

know and understand the ECB document "Safe Hands"- Cricket's Policy for Safeguarding Children.


