If Footballers have no option but to share transport: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Journeys should be shared with the same individuals and with the minimum number of people at any one time – these individuals should remain in the same training group throughout the session Good ventilation (i.e. keeping the windows open) and facing away from each other may help to reduce the risk of transmission The vehicle should be cleaned regularly using gloves and standard cleaning products, with particular emphasis on handles and other areas where passengers may touch surfaces
