Regular coaching to be provided free for all ages and ability levels

Suitably qualified coaches to be appointed whenever possible

Coaching qualifications for Club members to be promoted and paid for by the Club

Funds to be set aside each year to cover these costs

All Club members to be encouraged to attend regular coaching

Consideration will be given to Club members who are actively coaching teams in relation to subscription relief.

All coaches to abide by:
