

## First Aid

- Full details/descriptor will be sent out in the next few weeks
- RFU Emergency First Aid in Rugby Union course will be launch as on 1<sup>st</sup> August (with the booking centre taking bookings from the 3<sup>rd</sup> May). The process will be the same as booking CPD courses.
- £50 per person this is very competitive with of other courses on the market that are the equivalent on the national framework (i.e. Emergency First Aid at Work or Level 2 Sports First Aid)
- Clubs/schools etc. are able to do other course however only the RFU course will be recognised on the GMS system
