Bar re-opening policy and rules

The PGCC Executive Committee have put together the following to enable the club to make bar sales to members. We would ask that you respect these policies/rules until such time we can relax them as advised by the Government.

Failure to do so will result in the shutting of the bar and possible closure until further notice

1. If you are unwell or have any symptoms of Covid (as with playing rules), please stay at home.
2. All bar sales (alcoholic and non-alcoholic) will be takeaway and not for consumption on, or adjacent, to the premises. For the purpose of these rules, on the premises means the clubhouse, veranda and patio, adjacent to the premises means at least 3 metres from roped off area around the patio
3. Bar sales will be from the middle doors of the clubhouse only, no one is to enter the clubhouse for the purpose of drinks purchase, with bar staff and customers wearing masks whilst on, or adjacent, to the premises
4. Customers are to keep at least 2 metres apart whilst queuing to purchase drinks, with only one customer at a time to be at the purchase area. Customers are requested to 'queue' from the left hand steps and leave from the middle steps (leaving the right hand steps clear)
5. All purchases will be electronic, with no cash accepted. Only members will be served and no children are allowed in the 'service area'
6. No tables or chairs will be provided by the club, if you wish to sit together please bring your own 'furniture'. Members using the bar are requested to observe 'rule of six/two family groupings' at all times. Member groupings should keep 2 metres apart. Members are responsible for their children whilst at the club
7. Empty drinks receptacles (plastic glasses, bottles, cans etc) are to be taken away by customers, please come with bags to take your rubbish away. Club officials and volunteers will not be providing a clear up 'service' and failure by club members to keep the club ground/surrounds tidy will result in closure of the bar
8. Toilets facilities will be available in the clubhouse, accessible from the right hand steps. Entry to the clubhouse for the use of the toilets will require use of a mask until such time as current rules are relaxed
9. Current plans are for the bar to be open on Friday evenings (6.00 pm to 8.00 pm) and after senior games have finished on Saturdays and Sundays, weather permitting (this will be reviewed as the cricket season progresses)
