Chairman's Report	Full Chairman's report attached
Chairman's Report 2018.docx	There were questions regarding the questioning of the integrity of the committee. This was to do with the cost of the levelling of the outfield. It was discussed at 2 committee meetings and the minutes show that the decision was made to go ahead. The committee had also given the chairman a vote of confidence.
Secretary's /	Membership Secretary's report attached.
Membership Report Membership Secretarys Report 1	Kenton said that we need to carry on getting full payment from colts to cover Future Legends costs. There are some social members who enjoy the sensibly-priced bar tariff but do not believe they need to pay membership. The situation with the adults was the reason that Kenton is stepping down as there are some payers who benefitted from the work put in by the ground staff and social staff but who did not pay. The new membership secretary should be a cricketer to bring ideas about how membership fees should be paid in order to get all players paying. The admin side is in a good situation and will be very easy to maintain next year.
	The Secretary reported that she was standing down after 5 years due to work commitments, but was very proud of the achievements the club had made over that time.
	Steve Cowley asked that thanks to Evelyn and Ken were minuted.

Treasurer's Report	The Treasurer reported it had been very successful year. We had £19,500 in
PGCC ACCOUNTS 1718.xlsx	the bank at the start of the year and £30,000 at the end, in large part due to the bar which took £45,000 and made a profit of £18,000, so around 40%. This is lower than the target of $43-44\%$ but due to the fact that prices had not increased, but the committee are discussing the bar pricing.
	Subscriptions have increased substantially from £4,800 to £9,000, due to the increase in the number of colts. The money paid to Future Legends has increased from £4,000 to £6,000.
	There has not been as much expenditure on capital projects, but there are plans for this year. Ian thanked Karen Wooland for the work she has done regarding grants, which is so far achieved contributions of £3,000 with a lot more due and in the pipeline.
	There was discussion regarding potentially introducing remuneration for people who help to attract more people to help, but the constitution states that we are a volunteer-run club.
	The question of players not paying membership fees was discussed and the need to make sure we have two Saturday teams.
	The club will be getting broadband by the time the next season starts, which means that we will be able to take card payments which should help with both membership fees and bar takings.
	The meeting agreed to adopt the accounts.
Colts Plan / Report	Colts plan and Club Development report attached.
CM_Criteria_ID04_C olts_Plan 2019_Revie	Kevin said that the elements raised are in terms of cost management and scalability. We need to set targets and criteria for Future Legends, and rules to manage numbers. We need to ensure that all colts are getting quality coaching. There are also external challenges as the ECB want to change the format. There was discussion around how many teams to have and whether to enter leagues. There are also 3 or 4 juniors who are potentially available for adult games to bridge the gap. John asked that we agree having 70 colts as a maximum.
	Kevin thanked the people who have helped run the colts and in particular the Friday night sessions.
	Peter wanted to thank the adult team members who came to training, games and the awards night as it makes a big difference.
Club Development	Club Development report attached above.
	Kevin said that we have tried to look at the club as a whole, inside and out in terms of improvements. Money has been set aside for 3 mobile cages with strips on the square dedicated to practice. The shutters will be replaced with electric ones. There are elements in the clubhouse that could be improved, particularly the kitchen, the home showers and the layout. He asked what the members saw as priority.
	There was discussion around the lack of nets. We have had a survey for physical nets but they can only go near the road. The issue with mobile nets is that we need nets for practice during the week and on match days. It was agreed that the chairman would look into the cost of refurbishing the existing net.

	<ul> <li>The levelling of the outfield and the BT line have been funded. The entranceway has been improved by the National Trust and we have contributed towards it. We have given funding for Nigel Bruce to do a recruitment drive in senior schools over the winter. In addition, air conditioning behind the bar and water facilities for players have been agreed.</li> <li>The recent survey carried out had 60 responses and the committee will receive a summary of the findings.</li> <li>From a players point of view, the priorities are nets and showers. The shower situation can be resolved by removing the rubbish, and also rubbish from the loft and the containers. This will be done early next season.</li> </ul>
