COVID GUIDELINES

The PGCC Executive Committee has put together the following guidelines to ensure we, as a Club, take every available measure to safeguard players, officials, coaches, volunteers and spectators, and reduce the risk of spreading Covid 19. We would ask that you respect our Club rules until such time as we can relax them as advised by the Government.

1. If you are unwell or have any symptoms of Covid, please stay at home. All participants (including players, officials, coaches, volunteers and spectators) must undergo a self-assessment for any COVID-19 symptoms prior to leaving their house to participate in cricket activity.
2. If you start to feel unwell during the game please go home. We encourage all players, officials, coaches, volunteers and spectators to report any infection of their household to the NHS test and Trace system following the use of our facilities to limit the spread of the virus.
3. Please arrive changed to play.
4. Please do not wear studs on the veranda or in the Clubhouse.
5. Please maintain social distancing from team players when not batting. We are an open site.
6. For batsman – running lines for batsmen to ensure players remain 2 metres apart where practical. However, 1 metre + is permissible where the wicketkeeper stands up to the stumps.
7. Bring your own teas – none will be provided.
8. Pavilion is only open for toilets.
9. Bar will not be open (sorry!) Welcome to bring your own refreshments.
10. Visiting teams must provide the home captain with a list of players & contact numbers (best they scan our QR code as well).
11. Any spectators must stay away from the pavilion and bring their own chairs as no seating can currently be provided.
12. Sanitisation every 6 overs or every 20 minutes, whichever comes first. This includes your hands and the ball.
13. Please avoid the sharing of equipment.
14. Please bring with you a Club First Aid kit to help reduce the spread of Covid. Ice packs will be available.
15. Lastly, we ask you to take away all your rubbish as there are no bin facilities at the Club to reduce the spread of Covid.
