

With torrential storms leaving Islip playing fields rather more than well-watered, it seems absurd that we are spending time worrying about how best to install a water supply to the cricket square, but that is exactly what we are doing as we prepare for the season ahead. Thanks go to Neil Brock for leading on this. Meanwhile work on the changing room floor is expected to start on March 30<sup>th</sup>, thanks to Laura Swanston (Village Hall Committee) and all of those who supported our fundraising. It is not exactly cricketing weather at present but hopefully we don't have too long to wait. The AGM and Club Dinner (thanks Pete Desmond) are at the Red Lion from 7.00 p.m. on Friday March 27<sup>th</sup> - not so very far away. The season proper starts in mid-April with a home game against Bletchington on April 19<sup>th</sup>, the week after Easter.

#### Preparing for the season

Rob Eason of University College has again done winter work on the pitch and it looks to be in good shape, if in need of a trim (rotary mower needed – can anyone help?) when the weather permits. The outfield that serves as a football pitch has suffered a bit over the last few weeks but should recover, perhaps not buy April 19<sup>th</sup> though, so we will have to make do.

Weather permitting; we'll aim to do some early work on the pitch in April, with ground work days on Saturdays in April, provisionally set to start at 11.00 am on April 4<sup>th</sup> and the 18<sup>th</sup>. We have again separated the annual dinner from the grounds days, so for once hangovers will not be an allowable excuse for non-attendance. Please mark both dates in your diary; a few hours work will make a big difference. As well as work on the pitch and in the groundsman's shed, there are other things to tackle. Pete Desmond and Rick Henshaw will again renew their commitment to painting the sightscreens (as they seem to do every year). We need to do some work on the nets; the nets themselves need reattaching (cable ties needed), and they also need a sweep and a roll. The pitch mower is being overhauled at some expense (thanks Kevin for organising this). We need to check the other equipment and fuel supplies as well. The pitch covers need to be reassembled, and, finally, the furniture needs to be put back in the changing rooms following the refurb. We probably need new waste-bins and a replacement for the old metal drawers.

Islip CC members tend to make their own individual preparation for the start of the season, and we are not running any Islip nets this year. #### Clubman of the Year

- 1. Candidates must be nominated by a proposer and a seconder at or before the AGM.

- 4. The proposer (or seconder) for each candidate will be invited give a short address (max 2 minutes) to the assembled dinner guests on the merits of their candidate.
- 5. All those present at the Dinner (rather than just the players) will then vote for their Clubman of the Year.
- 6. The previous year's winner is barred from standing.
