

Parents need to do three things when joining the Club:

- 1. Sign up with the Club on Pitchero and download the Pitchero app
- 2. Pay subs
- 3. Register and affiliate your child on the RFU's GMS system


1. Signing Up with the Club

Go to hampsteadrugbyclub.co.uk

Click on Join in the top right hand corner – this will take you to the screen below. **Please note the blue box ('Signing up for your child?')**

Fill in the details **for you** and then click 'Join this club'.

Note the password is required to be 10 characters long.




This will take you to the screen below. You are required to sign up to the terms of service and Hampstead RFC Consent.

Validate you are a human and hit next.



This will take you to the screen below. **You are still entering your details.** Parents should apply to be a **Club Member** and **Parent**, not a **Player** (unless they also want to play for an adult's team).

You will then see the following screen:




Start typing the name of your child in the box. If they are not already on the system you will see this message:



Now you are adding your child's details. Click on the drop-down box. Fill in their details – First name, Last name, which team they are applying for – and click Add. You will then have the chance to add additional children if you have more than one joining the club.



If you don't have any additional children click 'Next step' and it will take you to the final screen below.



You will have received an email please click on the link to validate your email address.

Returning to the above screen, clicking my account allows you to enter your address and there is a link to the Club's Code of Conduct that you are required to sign up to, and the junior help agreement and media consent preferences.








Go to Manage Roles




Click Manage....

Search for your existing child, then click the prompt to add a new member.



Fill in the name and team details for the new child and click Add child to submit the application....



There may now be a slight delay as the club is required to review and validate you and your child's application

Once approved, please log into your account and you will see your child's name; selecting this you will have a button to **Update Info** for your child's record. Please complete as much information as possible, but at a minimum:

- · Their date of birth
- An emergency contact name and number ("ICE")
- Any medical information that we need to know (eg allergies) if there are none type N/A to confirm it has been reviewed
- · Agree to the code of conduct on their behalf

2. Paying Subs

We allow new players three 'taster' training sessions before we ask you to pay subs. Our subscription fees have two parts:


- One 'Minis and Juniors' subscription per child per season (currently £60); AND
- One 'Parent' subscription per family per season (currently £60).

So if you have one child at the club, the annual subs are £120, two children = £180 etc.

3.Register your child on the RFU's GMS system
