INTRODUCTION



As a charity, Harvesters FC has a purpose and a sole duty to promote the game of football and provide playing opportunities in our community for all.

Community

Set up in 1987, Harvesters was born from a passion for the grassroots game and a desire to create a safe, inclusive and enjoyable environment for children to play football – a foundation which continues to permeate everything the club does today. At the heart of this is our all-weather pitch which was built thanks to a £221,250 grant from the Premier League, The FA and the Government's Football Foundation.

The pitch was formally opened in 2003 by Lee Dixon. With hard work and dedication from club volunteers, Harvesters have built a financially sustainable model, centred around their facility, to ensure the club's future.

Since our initial grant, Harvesters have twice self-funded the replacement of our artificial surface so the local community can benefit from the highest standard of pitch.

Professional Coaches

Our professional coaches lead the football coaching provision for our foundation teams up to the age of U13 and provide mentoring support to all the team managers at the club. Our professional coaches will have qualifications ranging between FA level 2 to UEFA B Licence.

Team Managers & Assistants

Our team managers are generally parent volunteers and all are DBS checked and have a minimum of FA level 1 coaching certification, including Health & Safety and Safeguarding. From feedback it's highly rewarding to have the opportunity to manage a team, if you're interested in managing a team, please contact the club.

Registration Process

- A New Player form will need to be completed and sent to your corresponding manager
- We will require a digital photo (passport quality) and a digital copy of passport or birth certificate for ID.
- A link will be sent to you from our club app, Pitchero (be sure to download the App!) for you to join and with payment information and details of payment options.

Training Schedule 2023-2024

Each team will have one hour long training session provided each week. We ask you to arrive at least 10 mins ahead of your session so they can begin promptly. Your team manager will advise on the time of your training session and the full schedule is available on the website, see the links. The training session will be the same for the season and you will be advised if this is likely to change ahead of next season.

Safeguarding

Safeguarding is of the highest importance at Harvesters. All our committee members, coaches and managers undertake a full DBS check and attending relevant training courses/ certification, according to their role. For more information, please click <u>here</u>.



Fixtures

Girls matches through the Hertfordshire Girls Football Partnership League (HGFPL) is played on a Saturday morning. Boys matches through the Watford Friendly League (WFL) and West Herts Youth League (WHYL) matches are played on a Sunday.

There will be a general rule of kick off time for each team, but subject to change in the event in unforeseen circumstances (weather, postponements, dispensation for afternoon kick off). Teams are required, in general, to arrive 30 minutes prior to kick off time for warm-up and team talk.

Communication

Most of our communications to you will be via Pitchero, for which you'll receive notifications accordingly once you've downloaded the app. You can also use the app to contact us, although in most instances, your manager would be your first point of contact.

Being On-Site

We have a strictly no dogs policy on our site. Various chemicals are used to treat and maintain the pitches and the last thing we would want is for any dog to become poorly. Other rules include

- Respect
- Spectators must remain behind respect barriers at all times
- Do NOT climb on the barriers
- Always respect the match officials decisions
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive behaviour.
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Remember children play for FUN
- Only players and coaches are permitted on the field of play inside the respect rails
- NO warming up on the pitches especially the goal area, there are warm up areas by every pitch
- Managers/coach please stay in your technical area
- All goals must be locked up after use
- Please do not sit or jump on the pitch side barriers, they are not designed to take excess weight
- Only players & managers are permitted beyond the gates of the AWP
- Appropriate footwear must be worn, NO FLAT TRAINERS OR BLADES ALLOWED
- Footwear must be clean do not warm up on the grass
- All manager/coaches must stand at the side of the pitch. NOT in the middle by the net
- All goals must be put back after use


The Kiosk
