Funding

To help support volunteers delivering sport within the community there are a number of funding opportunities available:

Fife Council Community Sports Grants

Grants are available to encourage, support and promote the training and development of sports coaches and officials.

All courses must be recognised by the sportscotland recognised Governing Body (or equivalent body). Applicants must be actively coaching or officiating at a club, community centre or sports centre in Fife in a voluntary capacity.

The grant will only be awarded on proof of attendance and successful completion of the course.

Applicants can receive grants of up to 50% of the total course costs, up to a maximum of £200.

Individual Learning Accounts Scotland (ILA Scotland)

ILA Scotland is a Scottish Government scheme that helps you pay for learning that you can do at a time, place, pace and in a way to suit you. It's for people who have an income of £22,000 a year or less, or who are on benefits.

If you are 16 or over and living in Scotland, you could get £200 towards the cost of learning with a learner account from ILA Scotland.

SportScotland UKCC Funding

SportScotland recognises the importance of new coaches coming into sport and the need for accessible, affordable coaching courses to be available to them. 2011 sees the roll out a new UKCC funding model to support the recruitment of new coaches.

By filling out the relevant application form eligible applicants can access funding towards the cost of UKCC endorsed qualifications.

Applications must be made at least four weeks prior to the start of the course; retrospective applications will not be accepted.

Swimming - Level 1 UKCC Teacher of Aquatics

The Level 1 Certificate for Teaching Aquatics is the first formally assessed qualification on the Scottish Swimming qualifications pathway. The course comprises two units, with the first focusing on "how to teach" skills with the technical emphasis on movement literacy (as defined by Long Term Athlete Development - LTAD). The second unit has a specific focus on Teaching Aquatics; technical knowledge and practical skills that will allow you to fulfill the role of a Level 1 Swimming Teacher.

Once qualified the holder of a Level 1 Teacher of Aquatics qualification is able to actively support a Level 2 Teacher of Aquatics in the delivery of a pre-prepared lesson. You will have an understanding of Scottish Swimming, basic movement literacy, core aquatic skills, LTAD and basic correction of common aquatic strokes.

Swimming - Level 2 UKCC Teacher of Aquatics

The Level 2 Certificate for Teaching Aquatics is the second formally assessed qualification on the Scottish Swimming qualifications pathway. The course is made up of six units which encompass all aspects of teaching within an aquatic environment. 
