TONIGHT'S VISITORS



Bewdley Town Football Club, as it is now known, was formed in 1978, following over 90 years competing under various local names.

The club was formed with the merger of two local teams, Bewdley Old Boys and Woodcolliers, both teams originally playing at Gardeners Meadow. The ground at Gardeners Meadow was sold for re-development, so after a massive fundraising project the club were able to purchase land at Ribbesford Meadows under the guidance of Robert Burns.

After playing in the Kidderminster and District Leagues, in 1999 the club joined the West Midlands Regional League Division One South.

In 2005, Bewdley Town finished runners up in Division 1 and gained promotion to the West Midlands Premier League, however in order for them to compete at this level, they had to ground-share at Stourport Swifts.

In 2006 permission was granted to build stands and floodlights at Ribbesford Meadow, and in their second season, Town finished 3rd in the league.

In 2007-8 the ground had been given a higher rating allowing them to compete in matches at a higher level and gain promotion if they finished in any of the top places. Bewdley Town FC also made history in this season, when they were allowed to enter the F.A. Vase for the first time, reaching the 3rd round, losing to Coventry Sphinx.

The following season saw Bewdley make their appearance in the FA Cup, although short lived, when they lost at home to Midland Alliance side Alvechurch FC.

The following seasons saw Bewdley, under the guidance of joint managers Craig Payton and Brian Lacey, become one of the top sides in the West Midlands Regional League. The club's hard work in developing Ribbesford Meadow was recognised by an award from "Groundtastic Magazine" for the best stand in the lower levels of non-league football!

The 2008/09 season saw Bewdley Town reach the final of the Worcestershire Senior Urn, losing narrowly to Studley 3-2 at Aggborough, but two years later in 2010/11 season, they gained their revenge beating Studley 2-1, and retained the trophy in 2011-12 by defeating Alvechurch in front of a 500+ crowd.

Bewdley Town were awarded the Charter Standard Adult Status in April 2012 and together with their successful Youth Section, are striving towards Community Club Status.

May 2014 saw an era come to an end, when joint managers Craig Payton and Brian Lacey decided to retire. The vastly experienced Phil Mullen & former Kidderminster Harriers striker Paul "Ocker" Davies came in. Town finished that season in 17th position, whilst winning the Worcestershire Infirmary Cup.

In 2016-17 the club entered won the Smedley Crooke Charity Cup at the first time of asking. During the close season, the club also obtained an FA grant enabling them to have major drainage work done to the main pitch. In 21-22, and the restructuring of the non-league pyramid, with a superior PPG record, Town were placed into The Midland Football League Premier Division where they remain today.

The Saltmen made it 4 wins in a row to climb to the summit of the Midland Football League Division 1. Droitwich started the game brightly and carved out numerous chances in the opening 10 minutes but Perry Moss and Charlie Tilley were both denied by Tyler Williamson. Heather and the Divisions' leading scorer Kyle Jardine had a great opportunity to give Saints the lead, but his effort was way off target when well positioned. Another chance fell to Connor Collins but his header from Lemon's cross lacked power. Against the run of play, on 14 minutes, Joel Chadwick spilled a cross from a Heather corner which was then only cleared as far as Hopewell who pummelled a fierce drive from 20 yards into the roof of the net. The goal took the wind out of Spa's sails who were sloppy for the remainder of the half. Heather could and should have taken advantage as Jake McLeary had Kyle Jardine spurned excellent chances. Sam Hurdman appeared to be tripped in the box when he raced on to a through ball with only Williamson to beat, but the referee showed the Spa man a yellow card for simulation. Hurdman was subsequently stretchered off the pitch with 10 minutes of the first half left to play. Heather extended their advantage just before the break when some haphazard passing out from the back culminated with Jake Finnerty's precise 40-yard finish looping over a stranded Chadwick. Spa came out of the dressing room all guns blazing and within two minutes of the restart Charlie Tilley finished well from close range after tidy footwork from Moss. The returning Jack Davies then fired wide with a powerful drive, then on 57 minutes Tilley was brought down in the box after great determination to nick the ball from Hopewell Collins made no mistake from the resulting spot kick to make it 2-2. Spa got the winner when a corner was cleared as far as Moss who took a touch and rifled in a fine precision strike through a crowd of bodies into the bottom corner from 20-yards Collins, Moss and Krol could have added to the lead, whilst the Saints only noteworthy chance of the 2nd half fell to Jardine, who headed wide. Droitwich with a battling & important 3 points in front of a healthy crowd of 254.

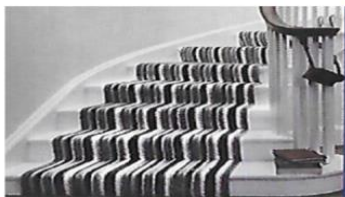
