Charter Standard Club of the Year

The Club are privileged to have won the Charter Standard Club of the Year award at the annual Birmingham County FA Grassroots Football 2018 awards.

225 clubs were nominated out of 4000 Midlands BCFA affiliated clubs, with the Moors coming out on top.

It is a fantastic achievement for the Club following another year of extremely hard work, which has seen the number of teams at Solihull Moors increase to 80 for the new season.

Sporting Director Mark Fogarty said: "This is a fantastic achievement and just reward for all the hard work the staff have put in over the last 12 months.

Ability Counts team represent Moors in Ireland

After an awe-inspiring end to the season for the Solihull Moors first team, a number of the Club's existing sponsors came together to provide the funds needed to send the open age disability team to an event in Dundonald, Northern Ireland.

Held annually, the George Best Community Cup is a five-a-side cup competition run by the Irish F.A that invites clubs that cater for players with a disability.

As leading advocates of disability football with over 75 ability counts players, Solihull Moors were invited to take their open age disability players to compete at the tournament between the 13th and 16th June.

Led by Charlie Fogarty MBE, the Club fielded two teams, one in the medium band of ability, while the others were in the low band in day one of the competition – both teams managed a couple of wins each.

The competition really got going on the second day and, after winning three out of their five games and drawing once, Moors' lower band side narrowly missed out on a place in the semi-finals on goal difference.

"Representing the whole of the footballing community is hugely important to us as a Club" said Arthur Dawes, General Manager at Solihull Moors.

He continued, "Having local sponsors that were willing to step in and make this trip happen has been a big boost to the Club, and to disability football as a whole in this region.
