Adults Code of Conduct



This Code of Conduct sets out the minimum standards that are expected by the Club and the Terms and Conditions upon which the Players undertake to be members of and to play for the Club.

- All players are responsible for helping to cultivate a thriving club community. It is expected that
 players support social functions at the club wherever possible and endeavour to attend the club
 post-match.
- Players are expected to celebrate each other's successes, and support one another on and off the field.
- Where possible, players are encouraged to volunteer their time to support the club's upkeep and development.
- The Club operates a NO PAY NO PLAY system. All Players are required to pay their annual subscription no later than 31st May in each year or make arrangements for payment with the Honorary Treasurer. After that date no players will be selected until subscriptions have been paid in full, or in accordance with an arrangement agreed with the Honorary Treasurer.
- Home and Away Matches: All Players must arrive at the ground and be ready to commence warm-up no later than the time stated by their team's captain at publication of that game's team selection. Individual players are responsible for organising their own transport to both home and away fixtures.
- All Players must pay their Match Fees on Pitchero within 72 hours of the completion of their match, or in accordance with an arrangement agreed with the Honorary Treasurer. Any Player who does not do this may not be selected until all outstanding Match Fees have been paid.
- All Players must wear club kit when representing the club in League and Cup matches.
- All Players agree to represent the club to the best of their ability and in a spirit of friendly competition in accordance with the Laws of Cricket and respect the umpires, opposition and other team members. Bad behaviour will not be tolerated.
- Players must give their availability on Pitchero no later than 17:00pm on Tuesday. It is the
 players' responsibility to check team selection, which will be published on both Pitchero and
 WhatsApp.
- Players expecting to play League and Cup cricket for the Club are expected to attend training whenever possible. Players' attendance at training sessions will be noted by the Cricket Committee and taken into consideration at selection meetings.
- No Player will be selected to play for the Club unless they have agreed to this code of conduct, to be formally approved by the individual on Pitchero during the subscription payment process.
