

International Tickets

Any member who has paid at least the normal full membership amount (£180.00 in 2019-2020) may apply for RFU-issued International Tickets. Family and Social members or anyone who has not paid the full amount (whether concession or otherwise) are not eligible to apply for tickets. You may increase your payment to the full amount at any point during the season and from that point on you will be eligible, but will be treated as a late payer. Grand Club, Honorary Life and other Exempt members are also eligible.

Details of when ticket applications are to be made will be placed on the Club notice board and web site. Members are advised to look at both of these regularly. We will not contact members excepting those who register an interest and provide us with an email address. You can register interest by emailing tickets@hoverugby.club with a subject of International Tickets. Please ensure that you type the subject precisely as shown above otherwise the system will not recognise your request.

You are advised that you should only apply for the amount of tickets that you specifically require. Applications for in excess of 4 tickets per game will require you to discuss these with the Ticket Secretary. You should note that you must pay in advance for every ticket for which you apply.

Any eligible member who requires being considered for ticket allocation should make their application to the Club using the International Match Ticket application form and send this with full payment (to include the administration fee and any membership dues) to the Club. Each form will be logged upon receipt and early applicants will be treated more favourably if demand exceeds allocation.

Members are reminded that no more than 50% of any allocation can be used for non members. Members may be asked to identify the recipient of each and every ticket issued to them. **Members are further reminded that under no circumstances should they ever sell on their allocation to a third party.** Any member who is found to have done this will be asked to appear before a disciplinary meeting. **You should be aware that should the RFU determine that a ticket has been sold in contravention of its regulations then the Club to whom the ticket was issued may be banned from ever receiving tickets again.**

AS THE RESULT OF A TRANSGRESSION BY A RECIPIENT OF INTERNATIONAL TICKETS DURING THE 2017-2018 SIX NATIONS SERIES, THE CLUB WILL BE RIGIDLY ENFORCING ALL REGULATIONS. SO, BE PREPARED TO HAVE YOUR APPLICATION REFUSED IF YOU DO NOT FOLLOW OUR PROCEDURES.

The Executive Committee has decided to utilise international match tickets for sponsorship purposes and thus a percentage of tickets allocated to the Club will be reserved for sponsors. It would be impossible to satisfy the demand for tickets out of the meagre allocation that we are given and members are asked for their understanding if they do not receive what they request. The ticket allocation mechanics performed are a holistic process and a full season's view is taken. Thus, for example, you may not receive any allocation for the autumn internationals but would be looked upon more favourably if you applied for the Six Nations and vice versa.

The Club also may receive a peppercorn allocation of tickets for England away games in the Six Nations. Applications for these should be made in the usual way. We generally do not receive any allocations for any games in which England are not involved.

Every ticket ordered – for home and away matches - must be paid for in advance. A flat rate charge of £135.00 per ticket is required, plus an administration charge of £10.00 per application, irrespective of the number of tickets applied for. Should you be unsuccessful, you will be returned £135.00 for each ticket applied for. The administration fee is not refundable. All refunds are made by the Club Treasurer and you should contact him in this regard. Should you receive tickets valued at less than the flat rate charge, you will be refunded the difference between the two values. So, for example, if you wanted four tickets for Game X then you would pay us $(4 * £135) + £10 = £550$, at the point of application, and if you then were allocated four tickets at £115.00 you would receive $4 * £20 = £80$ as a refund (admin charge not refundable). Similarly, a flat rate charge of £20.00 per child ticket, when available, is required.

Please note that juniors are deemed to be those aged 15 and under, and junior tickets cannot be purchased without at least one accompanying adult.

The closing date for applications AND payments for tickets for the 6 Nations via the club purchasing process is 12th September 2018. Applications and/or payments received after that date will not be accepted.
