

SECTION 1 – MEDICAL CONSENT

In an emergency situation, the club may act in loco parentis, if the need arises for the administration of emergency first aid and / or medical treatment which in the opinion of a qualified medical practitioner may be necessary. I also understand that in such an occurrence that all reasonable steps will be taken to contact me or the alternative adult which I have named on the form. I confirm that to the best of my knowledge, my child does not suffer from any medical condition other than those detailed by myself on the form

SECTION 2 – PHOTOGRAPHIC CONSENT

I give my consent for Oxted & Limpsfield Cricket Club to take photographs of my child solely for the use of their own promotion, I understand that the photographer will be fully vetted and if the club wish to use my child's photo for any other purpose they will contact me prior to doing so

SECTION 3 – AUTOMATIC SOCIAL MEMBERSHIP STATUS

Junior membership of the club provides one parent (carer/guardian) of the child with voting social membership of the club. U6/U7 membership does not include social membership. Additional social memberships can be purchased at a discounted rate of £30.

SECTION 4 – DATA PROTECTION

The club will use the information provided on this membership form to administer your child's cricketing activity at the club and in any activities in which they participate through the club and to care for and supervise activities in which they are involved.

In some cases, this may require the club to disclose the information to county boards, leagues and the ECB. In the event of a medical issue or child protection issue arising, the club may disclose certain information to doctors or other medical specialists and/or police, children's social care, the courts and/or probation officers and, potentially to legal and other advisers involved in an investigation

SECTION 5 – WEARING OF A HELMET

in recognition of the club's and ECBs rules regarding the wearing of helmets by players aged under 18, I confirm that my child will wear a helmet when batting against a hard ball, and if standing up to the stumps when keeping wicket and when fielding close to the bat. I also confirm that any new helmet purchased will be one which conforms to the latest British Safety Standards

SECTION 6 – CHILD WELFARE

As part of the normal organisation of training sessions and matches, club coach's/team managers and/or other colts' parents/guardians may enter changing rooms and, with the exception of club coaches, provide transportation. The club will apply reasonable care and diligence in this respect and I will advise the club of any special requirement in this regard. I understand that all qualified coaches have attended best practice in child welfare courses and that the club subscribe and adhere to the guidelines set out by "safe hands" the ECB's child protection policy

SECTION 7- CODE OF CONDUCT

The club hope to foster a positive and encouraging environment for all. The 'codes of conduct' are important statements of our intent in this regard. All members must read and confirm their support for this policy.
