Catering Assistant/ Cook

Responsibilities:

- Prepare the required food prep levels for projected trading on different days to include bar service, hockey tea provision and private events.

- Prepare dishes, following the recipes/ specifications provided for each dish, to ensure consistency and profit margins.
- Prepare orders in a timely manner and in the correct order to maintain customer satisfaction.
- Communicate any issues, out of stock items and wait times to the bar team.
- Order food from suppliers using the order sheets if requested by a manager.
- Maintain a clean and safe kitchen and ensure sanitation practices in the kitchen
- Ensure food safety management and date labelling is strictly adhered to as part of closedown procedures.
- Maintain compliance with all health & safety regulations when working in the kitchen area.
- Maintain compliance with all food safety regulations when working in the kitchen area.
- Complete daily paperwork when requested.
- Rotate stock items as per established procedures
- Properly store food items at appropriate temperatures
- Check the freshness of stock daily and discard any out-of-date items
- Maintain kitchen equipment by keeping it clean and looking after it.
