## Norwich Union Good Spectators Code of Conduct

Norwich Union Spectators are to act as positive role models to all players.

1. Respect guidance from the Norwich Union RFC with regard to spectator behaviour.
2. Remember sport is played primarily for players enjoyment, not for that of spectators.
3. Acknowledge good individual and team performance from all players irrespective of the team in which they play.
4. Respect match officials' decisions, even if they appear to be a mistake - remember, they are volunteers providing an opportunity for players to play rugby.
5. Never verbally abuse players, coaches, match officials or fellow spectators: such behaviour can create a negative environment for players and their behaviour will often reflect this.
6. Acknowledge effort and good performance rather than 'to win at all costs'.
7. (i) Verbally encourage all players in a positive manner, shouting 'for' not 'at' the players.  
(j) Encourage all players irrespective of their ability - never ridicule any individual player, regardless of the team in which they play
