The Role of the Scorer:

- A Scorer is required for every junior and senior game in Netball South Regional Leagues and most other competitions
- To sit on the officials table during matches, behaving professionally at all times and refraining from coaching, supporting or otherwise commenting on the game
- To ensure that players' names (printed in full) and details of the game are filled in before the game commences
- To record each centre pass, each goal and player positions quarter by quarter using the official score sheet (template provided by the competition)
- Where required by the competition (e.g. National Premier League) record the shooter's name and all shots made or missed
- To work closely with the opponent's Scorer to ensure that scores are agreed at all times during and after the match (typically by repeating the score aloud after each goal)
- To ensure that both umpires, team captains of each team, and other officials (where required by the Competition) e.g. Coaches, Managers, Timers, Primary Carers) sign the score sheet at the end of the match

The scorer will need to have:

- An ability to concentrate on the game and not be distracted
- A solid knowledge of the Competition rules and regulations
- An excellent understanding of how the Competition's score sheet should be completed (training, examples and other support is available)
- Legible handwriting
