The number of player members Swan can have in each age group is constrained by the following:

- The number of coaches within the club
- The availability of training venues
- The number of competitive leagues available to be entered.
- The availability of umpires.

Please Note: Places within Swan are not guaranteed for longer than one year. At the end of each season every player member will need to:-

- Trial for a place for the following season. In the younger years (U8's-U14's) this will be an informal assessment within the training environment. For U16 upwards there will be an official trial process.
- Have met the attendance at training and availability for fixtures criteria from the previous season in accordance with the Swan Attendance Policy (attached).
- Have adhered to the clubs codes of conduct.
- Keep Swan informed if they are moving from the club at the end of the current season.
