- If you have already registered on Slough Cricket Website, please log into your account
- 2. Once registered/logged in top right corner (should see YOUR name), click and from drop down menu choose membership
- 3. Click green JOIN button, then Club, and then search to choosing Slough Cricket Club

4. Apply for the relevant roles to you – filling in relevant info (make sure to scroll down) and if successful you will see under role that you have applied:

  - ii. For fields that aren't applicable please put N/A
  - iii. COLTS PARENTS register child(ren) by clicking on Parent role, and search for your child's name in the drop down box. If you search and they aren't listed please click on the 'Can't find a member you're looking for? Click Here to add a new member'. You will see you can add more than one child if this is needed
- You may need to apply for multiple roles e.g if you are a parent AND a full playing member, please apply for BOTH
