- Implement injury recording and auditing at the club.
- Provide remote support to medical staff on clinical issues and player management
- Work with coaching and management to ensure clear return to play pathways.
- Ensure concussion management and protocol is adhered to by all medical staff, players, coaches and management.
- Manage clinic staffing and player appointment times
- Provide pitch-side cover for all required games
- Arrange appropriate medical cover for all teams
- Assist players in pre-match preparation as required and provide pitch side injury assessment and immediate care
- Provide specific individual warm-up exercises for players returning from injury
