

Jon Dix – Goalkeeper – Having come through the club's youth system, Jon is a superb shot stopper and will be looking to continue his improvement in his 2nd year of Senior football.

Joe Goodey – Goalkeeper – This years Youth team goalkeeper, Joe has great agility and excellent distribution and will be looking to challenge for a starting spot this season.

Tom Hoskins – Defender – Entering his 3rd season with the club following his return from Shortwood United, Tom has great experience having played at a higher level with the likes of Bishops Cleeve and Wantage Town.

Ben Tunicliff – Defender – Ben returns to the club following a 2-year spell at Shortwood United, a force in the air in both boxes and someone who reads the game superbly well.

John Evans – Defender – John has taken to his new role superbly over the last year and offers bags of experience having also turned out for Brimscombe for a number of seasons at Hellenic Premier level.

Josh Comerford – Defender – Having recently moved to the area, Josh joins having played for Western League Side Bishops Sutton last season. Energetic with good quality on the ball.

Archie Woods – Defender – Another product of the clubs youth team, Archie can play in a couple of different positions and will always maximum effort and physicality.

Edd Major – Midfielder – Another in his 2nd season, Edd joined us from Hellenic Premier side Brimscombe and brings great experience as well as good energy. Will also weigh in with his fair share of goals.

Romain Thomas – Attacker – A new addition to the squad having been player manger at Cirencester Town Development last season. Started out as a young professional at Stevenage before appearing for numerous teams at varying levels of the non-league pyramid.

Stuart Midwinter – Attacker – Last seasons top goal scorer, Stu brings loads of pace and energy to the side as well as the will to work and defend from the front.

Corey Hill – Attacker – Another who steps up from Northern Senior football having been prolific for Tredworth Tigers. Great ability on the ball and an eye for goal.

James Barnes-Wills – Attacker – Yet another from our club youth system, James has electric pace and is ever improving in front of goal. Having hit well in to double figures last season he will be looking to improve on that this season.

Paul Holmes – Attacker – A great target man who always looks to bring others in to play. A selfless runner who always puts the team first. Another who will be looking to improve on his double figure goal tally from last season.

Deqwon Ebanks – Attacker – Deqwon joins from Bourton Rovers having also appeared locally for FC Lakeside. Powerful, quick and with great eye for goal, Deqwon is another who has played at various levels of the non-league pyramid.

History of Malmesbury Victoria FC

The Club was originally formed in 1898, and was known as Malmesbury Town, then Malmesbury United. Then in the 1960's, amalgamated with a successful Swindon Club known as Swindon Victoria. The Club has played in various locations in and around the Town before eventually settling on the present site, known as The Flying Monk Ground. The ground was previously owned by the pub known as The Flying Monk.

There have been ups and downs over the past few years, but in 1999/2000 the Club was extremely successful with both Saturday sides winning their respective Leagues for the first time since 1974. The first team won the Wiltshire Premier League to clinch promotion to the Hellenic League, with the reserves winning the equivalent Junior Division to gain promotion to the Premier Division.

During their first season in the Hellenic League the first team acquitted themselves well to finish 4th in the League. Since then things have been much harder to finish in the top half of the league, but in 2001/2002 the Club did win the Wiltshire Senior Cup. 2004/2005 saw the Club decide to start an Under 18's team in the Wiltshire Floodlit League.

The Club has made huge steps to improve the facilities, in the summer of 2004 the giant step of installing floodlights was completed and the summer of 2005 saw the complete refurbishment of the Clubhouse.

In the 2006/07 season, we were unlucky not to get promotion into the Hellenic Premier League, finishing in fourth place. The following season 2007/08, we had a poor start, and half way through, after a change of management finished the season in 15th place.

The 2008/09 season saw the Club finish in the runners-up spot in Division 1 West, and with it came promotion to the Hellenic Premier Division, this being the Club's highest level of football in its history. However, the Club was relegated at the end of 2009/10 as the ground had not reached the required standard to continue in that division.

After dropping down and asking local legend, Wayne Kibble to run the senior sides and return a focus to local players, the club saw great success in the Wilts premier league, ending in being champions in 2014/15 season and gaining promotion to the Western League for 2016/17 season and finishing in a very respectable 9th position. Following a mid-table finish in 2017/18, League re-structuring has seen the club return to the Hellenic League in the 1 West Division where we look forward to renewing old friendships and making new ones.

The Club is in the early discussion stages to move to a new ground close to the present one, but high enough not to have to worry about flooding.

Cheltenham Saracens • Club History

Formed in 1964 as part of a multi-sport club, they joined the Cheltenham League Division 5. Gradually the football section grew in strength and was soon running two sides in the Cheltenham League, two in the Stroud & District, two Sunday teams and several youth teams.

In 1986 the club were elected to the Hellenic League and stayed in Division 1 until they were promoted to the Premier Division in 1999/2000 with the second team also winning the Reserve Section

that same year. After two years in the Premier the team were relegated back to Division 1 in 2001/2002.

In 2015/2016 the club narrowly missed out on winning the Division 1 title but secured promotion to the Premier Division by finishing second, however the club decided to remain in Division 1. The club has now a strong base to move forward with three senior teams on Saturdays and junior teams aged between 6-14.
