Defending - The Poke Tackle Will need a partner to be in possession of the ball. Should be able to achieve with left and right feet	 See this link for demonstration of the skill Poke the ball using the front foot (one closest to the ball) Lock the ankle Weight is on the back foot Poke the ball at an angle (diagonal) Body weight forward to gain possession 	 Level 1 – Gets in correct position to make the tackle and approaches from the side Level 2 – As above, also pokes the ball using their front foot Level 3 – As above, also lock their ankle and put body weight on the back foot Level 4 – As above, also pokes the ball at a diagonal angle Level 5 – As above, also gains possession of the ball and dribbles it a few yards to demonstrate have control of it 	level e.g. to achieve Level A, they just need to do it approx. 250 times with each foot, not 500
