Dear Parents/Carer,

Safely resuming football matches

The committee are excited to let you know that we are now planning our return to outdoor face-to-face matches from September. Given the fact that we're still recovering from the COVID-19 pandemic, there'll be some restrictions on what we do and how we do it. This letter will let you know the steps we've taken to make sure we keep everyone safe.

Firstly, anyone with COVID-19 symptoms, or who has been in contact with anyone who has COVID-19 symptoms (within the last two weeks), shouldn't come to any face-to-face activities, and should follow government guidelines on self-isolation and testing.

Secondly, young people who are shielding or are in another vulnerable group might not be able to return to matches at this stage. If you or your child is shielding or in another vulnerable group, please contact your manager directly so they can chat through some options.

I would also like to let you know some of the updates to our arrangements for making sure our activities will be COVID-19 safe.

Arrival and departure arrangements

• We would ask that parents do not lift share. If this causes problems, please let your manager know. Arrival and departures instructions will be made available to you each week for away matches.

Hand sanitisation, hygiene and personal protective equipment

 Every Young Person MUST bring their own hand sanitiser and water bottle, without these they will not be able to attend the match or training. Coaches will have PPE available to them if they need to administer First Aid.

Social distancing

- Current FA regulations will be adhered to and we will advise if there any changes to these.
- It is important your Young Person will stay in the team ("bubble") that they are allocated to, they cannot change teams.
- Supporters (Family Groups) must stay 2 metres away from other family groups or be prepared to give their details for contact tracing. If supporters stay more than 2 metres away then there is no need for contact tracing.

Other measures in place

 Please ensure your Young Person goes to the toilet prior to coming, it is unlikely that facilities will be open.
