Swindon Cricket Club is always open to new members – young and old! We are proud to say we are the biggest cricket club in the Swindon area and are run by a committed group of volunteers who are passionate about cricket, providing cricket opportunities in our community and being a local asset.

Cricket

- We run four teams on a Saturday, an evening league team, a Wiltshire Wallop T20 team, play
 a few friendlies and Sunday games and have two indoor sides lots of opportunities to play
 cricket!
- Outdoors general club training is during the season on a Wednesday night at our ground 6-8pm (weather dependent).
- The first team also train on a Tuesday night by invite only.
- Training sessions are attended by our head coach, Wayne, who helps run group activities and can work with individuals as necessary.
- Training sessions are free, while matches have small match fees (they vary between teams but always less than £8 for a full Saturday game). Match fees help cover costs for balls, umpires, teas etc.
- On Saturdays, drivers to away games can claim 20p per mile if they travel with a full car or players/officials.

Membership

We are a member's club, run by members, for members (in line with our constitution). Membership rates in 2020 are: Adult Playing Member (£100), 16+ Student/Full Time Education (£80) and Adult Club/Non-Playing Member (£20). Those with a coaching qualification who regularly help run a side/session can apply for FREE membership.

Membership helps the club to provide cricket for all its members and goes towards all sorts of costs, such as maintaining and improving our facilities, use of our top grade facilities, coaching, insurances, ground rates, training, health and safety, coach qualifications, utility rates, league fees, equipment, subsidised indoor training in the winter and many, many more!

Players are also expected to play in a club shirt displaying our main sponsors name, available from our online shop. Coe Capital continue to be great supporters of the club and as such it is expected that EVERY player wears the new club shirt baring their name – it really is the least we could do.
