

SURFSIDE WAVES TERMS & CONDITIONS – VOLUNTEERS

Upon completion of registration, the Coach/Committee member/Volunteer (or if the Volunteer is under 18 at the time of registration, the Volunteer's Parent or Guardian) agrees:

- * the Volunteer is a member of Surfside Waves Soccer Club (SWSC);
- * the Volunteer has registered on the Club website with current contact details; and
- * in addition to compliance with those Laws, Statutes, Regulations and other matters set out in FFA/FV PlayFootball Terms and Conditions, the Volunteer agrees to be bound by, and observe, the Club's Constitution, By-Laws and Codes of Conduct (all documentation available upon request and also found on relevant websites).

By agreeing to the Terms and Conditions, you the Volunteer (or parent or Guardian) agree that:

- * your photo or video image may be used by Surfside Waves Soccer Club in relation to promotional material on the Club's social media, including the Club's Pitchero website & apps, Facebook, TeamApp, Instagram and Twitter, within the newsletter and in other Club documentation, and in local newspapers.
- * you undertake to look after any Club equipment and return it in a clean and reasonable condition at the end of use; and return any equipment, including balls, gloves, and any relevant items loaned for use during the season, or you will cover the costs of purchasing replacement item/s;
- * you will take all reasonable measures to ensure SWSC is aware of any pre-existing medical conditions and make available to the Club (or Club representative, eg. Coach/Committee member) at each training session, game and/or event, any medication you may require;
- * in the event of a medical emergency, you agree to emergency medical treatment as seen to be required by SWSC, and agree to cover the costs of ambulance, dental, hospital or other medical costs incurred;
- * you have registered your current contact details on the SWSC website contact information and on the PlayFootball registration site, including changes of address, phone numbers and emergency contact details, and will keep these records updated as any changes may occur;
- * you will pay any fines imposed by FFV. Should you receive a monetary fine(s) as a result of misconduct, you agree to pay the fine(s) in full within 6 weeks of notification of the fine. Failure to do so may result in the Club deeming you ineligible to participate in any Club events, and you will be considered to be 'in debt' to the club for the full amount of the fine(s) imposed by FFV. No future family registrations or participation in Club Events will be permitted, until this debt is paid.
- * you understand that SWSC will share personal details obtained through registration only with Parent Organisations FFA and FV as required for administrative and playing purposes. SWSC will not voluntarily distribute any of your personal information to third parties without your permission.
