### Colts (U20s)

Season 2019 was one of many mixed results and problems – having retained 95% of the players that participated in 2018, we were at the beginning of January in a better place than 2018.

Player retention for 2019 and player recruitment was however hampered by the inability of WA Rugby to provide a realistic competition due to its sheer stupidity in mismanaging the rugby union grade system in W.A. Something we hope will be reviewed and improved in 2020 season and beyond.

We played marginally more games in 2019 than we did in 2018 by some 3 games all while having patches of one week on and one week off during the season , coupled with holiday breaks of 2 weeks to accommodate University, Associates and Kalamunda rugby clubs, this season was disjointed at best.

Despite this we managed to win 1 and draw 1 during the season with some games being beaten by 30 points and others by 2 to 3 points. All in all, not great results as far as the score lines, and making the top 4 of the competition.

Yet despite these factors we have had 11 players from the group of 18 (regulars) play senior rugby either at 3rd, 2nd or first team levels. All of which played above the standard of the majority of player in the relevant grade. This indicates that we are on track to provide as per our primary remit players that will make the grades within the club into the future - the majority being fit for seconds and first grade levels.





Looking forward to 2020 and given the continued lack of recognition of players into the development program as it is currently run, the club needs to consider that external touring is the best method of retaining players. Whether that is overseas or interstate is yet to be discussed. However, there needs to be some form of growth outside of the club environment for all players and not just Colts.

As a Colts squad we will commence 2020 with 13 players remaining eligible for colts by age from the current group, with some 5 players moving upwards from the under 17 age group and 5 moving upwards to senior rugby.

This still requires a minimum of 3 players in specific position wanted to fully complete the squad - (1 Lock, 1 Center, 1 Prop) until the younger players have time to bed into the Colts competition.

### **All Abilities**

2019 has been Season 3 of the Southern Lions Senior All Abilities Rugby Union Team and Season 1 of the Southern Lions Junior All Abilities Rugby, and has been successful and most enjoyable for all concerned.

The All Abilities continues to grow slowly with up to 18 players on the list for seniors and 11 for the juniors.

The seniors continue to be supported by the SCRUM competition who has allowed us to compete in an exhibition match at the end of their carnivals. There is no doubt that that the standard has grown considerably over the past 2 seasons with a lot of support from the coaches. Special mention should go to Justin Arthur (Head Coach), Michael (Red) Cairns and Dave Reid (Parent and sponsor), whose input has been tremendous. There has been very little drop off of players with most of them playing in the Carnivals at least. We have seen 4 new players this season arrive to train and play. The players travel from as far away as Scarborough, Wanneroo, Rockingham and Safety Bay as well as our local area.

The Junior All Abilities have grown to 11 players, whose attendance has ben determined by many factors, such as cold and flu, specialist appointments and sometimes lack of motivation. This has been a very challenging group to work with given their disabilities, Autism, William Syndrome and Intellectually challenged. They are young and striving to live in the "real world" which is challenging for them at the best of times. The rugby program has challenged them to the max.

Our Peer Support system has been tremendous to say the least. Brennen, Josh, Connor, Kynan, Lauren and Athan have far surpassed my hopes and expectations. It has







been difficult to keep the "Buddies" occupied at times with lack of numbers but they have stuck at it.

It is difficult at times dealing with the junior AB's children who lack the ability to behave in a manner, which is acceptable. One disruptive child can affect the performance, behaviour and attitude of the whole group and as a result I have had to use many of the techniques that I have used throughout the years - time out, slightly raised voice, I have even moved a very large junior up to the Senior group (hasn't helped his behaviour but it does protect the smaller kids), the senior group are very accepting and tolerant of him and his behaviours I hasten to add. Dealing with strange and unacceptable behaviours is part of the challenge however and we have risen to it. Early days for the junior's but as they get older they will grow with the program.

Sponsorship has been very generous, the theft from my car created enough interest to raise over \$1250 on a go fund me page set up by a friend and referee - Jim Greaves. In all we have raised over \$8500 this season, which has helped towards, fees, kit, trophies, photos and equipment.

Membership fees and insurance for junior and seniors continues to be an issue. However with better monitoring we should be able to qualify all of our Juniors for Kid Sport and continue to raise money for the men through sponsorship next season.

































































