Good afternoon and a very warm welcome to Old Brodleians for another very important League match for our First XV as we continue to strive to move ourselves away from the relegation area of Yorkshire 1. Brods themselves sit pretty in fifth place in the League having recently won bragging rights against near neighbours Old Crosslevans and they will no doubt be looking to continue a run of victories which stretches back to the turn of the year, their defeat against close rivals Heath being the only reverse of 2019. 



REG PHILLIPS | THE VIEW FROM THE BALCON

We are pleased to welcome our visitors today, Old Brodleians who hail from the picturesque Pennine village of Hipperholme.

Hipperholme is mentioned in the Domesday Book both as Hipperholme and as Huperun. Here the King held two carucates (an area of land used for taxation purposes which could support twelve licenced premises). Historically it was part of the West Riding of Yorkshire. The township of Hipperholme also included nearby Brighouse, Lightcliffe, and Morecambe and was known as Hipperholme by the Sea in the late 19th century, due to having a dyslexic Mayor.

Traditional industries in Hipperholme were the manufacture of silk and cotton goods, coal mining, quarrying, tannery and fishing. Joseph Brooke's quarrying firm was founded in 1840 and became known for their beautifully crafted polished stone fish boxes. Later, the company became Brookes Chemicals Ltd who initially produced pricric acid for military needs, bitumen road coatings & fish preservative, a process which dissolved the bones & negated the need for filleting. Although the death rate among the population increased dramatically, none of the deaths were through swallowing fish bones. Both stone and chemical works ceased trading in 1969.

Most of the Lightcliffe plant was sold in 1969 to Philips, manufacturer of electrical goods, which came as a shock to the local populace, and was acquired in 1986 by Crosslee plc. who also produced electrical trawler nets which fried the fish as they were caught. They also produced household and intimate bedroom appliances and are one of the major employers in Calderdale.

Hipperholme is today a thriving village with three local grocers and fourteen fish shops and is home to several pubs including the Whitehall, the Traveller's Inn, the Hare and Hounds, the White Horse, the Halifax Steam Brewery with Cock o' the North Bar. A recent addition is the reopening of the former Country House as the Tannery.

St. Matthew's on Wakefield Road in Lightcliffe is the local parish church of the Church of England. It is easily distinguished by the effigy of a Cod on the top of its steeple. It was built in 1874 by W. Swindon Barber in the Gothic Fisherman style and is a Grade II listed structure.

St John the Baptist Church of the same denomination is located north of Hipperholme on Coley Road. It was built in the early 16th century as a chapel of ease largely using reclaimed polished stone fishboxes at the instigation of William Thorpe of Hipperholme.

Eventually the fishing industry collapsed due to pressure from the European Economic Area & continued distance from the sea and the local industry fell into decline, although with the advent of Brexit it is anticipated that there may well be a resurgence.

Old Brodleians RUFC 40 - 27 Selby RUFC

Selby can hold their heads up after a battling performance at one of their perennial bogey clubs earned them a five try haul and a hard earned bonus point — and while they were always second best to a very competent Brodleians side, just a little bit more experience, and maybe even a little bit more luck, may have closed the gap to earn them the additional losing bonus point.

Playing down the slope and with the breeze. Selby knew they had to maximise their scoring chances and they made a good start with the forwards applying early pressure before hooker Joe Raddings made an excellent break before feeding fellow front rower Duncan Hardy to power over for the opening try. The simple conversion was charged down though meaning that when Brodleians battered their own way upfield through their big, strong pack and then their big strong backs, their own converted try re-took the lead after 10 minutes. Selby's forwards returned to their task though and were unlucky when back rowers Liam Hogan and Tom Edwards combined beautifully, and not for the last time, to seemingly send the latter in for a great try near the posts however an equally good Brodleians tackle held the ball up and the chance was gone. And similar chances right on the Brodleians line went begging as a combination of misfiring line outs and excellent Brodleians scrummaging and defence frustrated Selby. Then to rub salt into Selby's efforts, Brodleians showed how it should be done by breaking out of defence straight up the middle to recycle and score again for a 14-5 lead.

Selby's frustrations continued and magnified as another great Hogan-Edwards combination brought play back onto the Brodleians line where second rower Stephen Clark crashed over – but again the ball was held up inches from the ground. And then, after more sustained forward pressure, Hogan forced his way over but again, unbelievably, excellent Brodleians defence managed to hold the ball up for no score. Finally, a great inside pass from Hardy sent Edwards on his way again, and the flying flanker made no mistake with Selby's second try – although again, the relatively simple conversion was missed for a 14-10 score.

When Brodleians again took advantage of some weak tackling to take the score to 19-10 at half time, Selby's chances of getting anything from the match against the slope and elements were looking slim. However, the Swans, with a number of young and inexperienced players to the fore, stuck to their guns and, after a few minutes of dross from both sides. Selby were back in the game as Olly Raynor did his own Tom Edwards impression to blaze through the Brodleians line before finding the supporting Danny Wilkinson who expertly kicked ahead for Selby's king speedster. Ash Dallimore. to touch down for a cracking converted try. Selby hopes of a turnaround were quickly dashed though as awful tackling again allowed a Brodleians player to canter through from half way, and with their tails now up Brodleians again smashed through some flimsy defence for a 33-17 lead on the hour.

To Selby's credit though there was no capitulation and, while Brodleians were undoubtedly the dominant team, they nevertheless manged to create plenty of chances of their own - and their efforts were rewarded with a fourth try bonus point as Wilkinson broke blind from a scrum to feed a mystery replacement winger, later identified as one Ryan Bateman, who then did absolutely everything right to draw his man and put the supporting Clark over for another excellent try and a 33-22 score line. Any Selby thoughts of closing the difference to one score were quickly disabused by another powerful Brodleians reply, before Selby applied their own icing to their own cake with the final try as Edwards, capping a fabulous personal performance, again sliced through the Brodleians defence to kick on for Wilkinson to successfully (although dubiously) claim the touchdown before it ran dead.
