Dear Member/Friend of Southwold Rugby

You are invited to join **The Southwold RFC 100 Club**, a fund-raising initiative whereby you could win up to £250 each month. **The 100 Club will start January 2023.**

This is how it works:

- Each month you will pay £10 into the Southwold RFC 100 Club's separate account by standing order which you can set up online or in branch. Alternatively, the payment of the year's subscription at £120 can be paid in full by bank transfer or by cheque.
- If you are paying monthly, the money needs to be paid into this account on the first day of each month (starting January 2023) for you to qualify for the draws. If paying in full, again by 1st January 2023.
- Having done this, please complete the attached form and return to Jane Webb **by 1st December 2022**
- On receipt of the completed form, you will be given a number.
- The monthly draws, the numbers for which will be gained by a random number generator, will be held at a pre-match lunch within that month or at monthly committee meetings out of season.
- There will be no cash prizes – all prize money will be transferred electronically and so don't forget to fill in your bank details on the form!
- Total prize money will be 40% of the monthly income. So if 100 people take part then prizes will be as follows: 1st prize £250, 2nd prize £100 and 3rd prize £50
- Prize money will change according to the number of members of the club.

What you need to do next:

- Read the attached sheet of Rules and Regulations.
- Set up a standing order with your bank. Please pay £10 into the new dedicated account commencing 1st January 2023 and thereafter on the 1st day of every month.
Or pay full payment for a year's subscription at £120 by 1st January 2023.

Southwold RFC 100 Club Rules and Regulations

- 1) The name of the Club is **The Southwold RFC 100 Club** and the object of the Club is to raise funds which will be used for targeted projects within the Southwold RFC.
- 2) The Club will be overseen by the President and Chairman of Southwold RFC and they will nominate an organiser.
- 3) The Southwold RFC 100 Club is open to individuals over the age of 18 years of age and membership is on completion of a 100 Club membership application form and payment of subscriptions.
- 4) Membership is valid for the period 1st January (or, if later, the month the members become eligible to participate in a draw) to 31st December each year. Subject to payments of subscriptions, membership will automatically renew for subsequent calendar years. New members will be entered into the draw providing their payment is received by the 1st day of that month.
- 5) Payments will be made into a separate dedicated Southwold RFC 100 Club bank account.
- 6) The subscription will be £120 per member per year. This should be paid in full on 1st January and every 1st January thereafter, or can be paid by Standing Order of £10 per month. Each member will be given a number which will be used for all draws following their admission to the Southwold RFC 100 Club. Members may have more than one number. Subscription must be received into the Bank Account by 1st of each month to be eligible for that month's draw.
- 7) The 100 Club will have a maximum of 100 members.
- 8) When the 100 Club has 100 members, a review will take place to increase the size of the club or keep it at 100 and new members will be admitted only as and when existing members leave. If this is the case, the organisers will keep a waiting list and will offer membership to the first eligible person on the list. The President and Chairman's decision on membership is final.
- 9) The Chairman and President will organise a monthly draw which will take place at a pre-match lunch within that month, or out of season, the draw will take place at the monthly Committee meetings.
- 10) The total prize money will be 40% of the monthly income - £400 if the 100 Club has 100 members. If this is the case, there will be three prizes: 1st prize £250, 2nd prize £100 and 3rd prize £50. Prize money may vary depending on membership of the 100 Club.
- 11) The numbers of all paid-up members will be entered in the draw for each month. The numbers will be drawn by a random number generator
- 12) The organisers will keep records of the name and address of each member, the number allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them.
- 13) Membership is not transferable.
- 14) A member will be treated as having left the 100 Club if he/she dies or the subscription is not paid by 1st January of the following year. Once paid, there will be no refunds of subscriptions.
- 15) The Chairman, President and appointed persons will agree on a quarterly basis what the monies raised will fund to support selected activities at Southwold RFC.
- 16) The Chairman and President's decision on the interpretation of the rules shall, except in the case of manifest error, be final.
