Accountabilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To assist in the planning and delivery of Tuesday and Thursdays training sessions as agreed with the lead coaches.• Be available and able to travel with the teams on all home and away games including a number of overnight stays prior to games.• To lead on areas of delivery as agreed with the lead coaches, currently scrum, lineout & restarts.• Assist the forwards to understand and execute their roles within the BSRFC attack and defence structures/patterns.• To review and analyse performance of both Bishop's Stortford and opposition teams through use of the appropriate match videos on Hudl and as provided by Pro Sports Analysis• To input on team selection• To share ownership of players' individual development plans as agreed with the Head Coach, working with players to develop their understanding of their own performance and to maximise strengths and mitigate weaknesses.• To assist in the administration and management of teams as required.• To support the broader Bishops Stortford RFC programme as required, for example running skill sessions, observing and feeding back to fellow coaches.• To contribute to the recruitment of players as agreed with the lead coaches.• To engage beyond the rugby programme in support of broader Bishops Stortford RFC aims.• Contribute to team culture and club ethos through championing & exemplifying BSRFC values.
