Introduction to Kidderminster Carolians RFC

With Kidderminster Harriers F.C. now a member of the Football League, it is not commonly known that they were once a very successful rugby union team. Starting life as an athletic club in the mid-1870s, they formed a rugby club and were very good. There were several clubs in the town including one called Kidderminster, but the two sides never met. "Kidderminster" eventually folded.

The "Harriers" had six very happy seasons. They had a good fixture list with plenty of top clubs, and to the surprise of many opted for soccer in the late 1880s. In 1923 Kidderminster re-formed and in 1937 another club emerged, namely Old Carolians. They were the old boy's team from King Charles 1st Grammar School that had been in the town for some four hundred years. The 1939-45 war saw the Carolians cease playing, but Kidderminster played on throughout this period. Carolians started up again in 1948, and for many years the annual Derby was eagerly awaited. There had always been talk of an amalgamation, and although there were opponents in both camps, it eventually came about in 1969. The new club became Kidderminster Carolians RFC (KCRFC).

Since the amalgamation, KCRFC has made steady progress and is now a well-established and highly-regarded club with first-rate facilities and a loyal following. The Mini and Junior Section goes from strength to strength and is a vital part of the Club with teams from micros right through to Colts.

As the popularity of the game of rugby in the locality has grown, and new clubs such as Stourport, Cleobury and Chaddesley Corbett have emerged, KCRFC has remained pre-eminent.

Last season the 1st XV retained the North Mids Shield and the Vets XV won the Stourbridge Memorial tournament and toured Malta. Our Colts team also saw success reaching the semi-finals of the cup.

KRFC Membership Subscriptions

To be a registered member of Kidderminster Carolians Rugby Club and the national Rugby Football Union, each player must fill in a KCRFC Membership Form. Mini Junior players will also need to supply a passport photo if you have not previously done so. These forms are available at the club or from team managers.

By registering with KCRFC and the RFU you are covered by the RFU insurance but we do however recommend that separate more comprehensive sport insurance be taken out as the RFU insurance only covers for worst case scenarios.

KCRFC membership is annual and the subscription fee must be paid at the start of the season in September each year. Subscriptions cover training and matches as well as food for all home games. These also help cover the cost of training, ground and club maintenance, club operational costs, replacement and upkeep of kit /equipment and entry to any tournaments/festivals.

Annual Membership for the 2017/2018 season will be:

Social/VP Membership - £49

- Players
- Senior Player - £64
 - Senior Student (in full time education) - £32
 - MJ Player (1xChild) - £64
 - MJ Player (2xChild) - £100
 - MJ Player (3xChild) - £140

Senior Players with MJ Player pay £64 plus £32 for each child.

Senior Membership to be paid to Sue Ross or left behind the bar.

Mini/Junior section to pay their membership to their Team Manager.

Membership can be paid by:

- Cheque, made payable to KCRFC (or cash!)
- When you are next at the Club you can pay by debit or credit card at the bar (minimal charges apply)

NOTE: Players will not be allowed to play in any matches until subscriptions are paid in full. Late payments after September 30th will incur a £10 additional charge.

Safety & Welfare

- Our philosophy at Kidderminster Carolians is to have fun and enjoy the game of rugby, supporting and encouraging players of all abilities. We aim to provide a safe environment for all and everyone has a part to play in this; Committee members, coaches, volunteers, players, parents and guardians.
- All players **MUST** wear gum shields.
- Boots must have BS kite marked studs. Please speak to your coach for guidance or see www.irb.com .
- We strongly encourage all parents who assist in coaching on a regular basis to gain RFU coaching qualifications. All squads must have at least one qualified coach who will have covered the following elements:
 - *Coaching and developing players
 - *Injury prevention and First Aid
 - *Child protection
- All Assistant Coaches, Coaches, Volunteers and Committee Members have undergone an Enhanced Certificate from the Disclosure and Barring Service.
- If you are not staying to watch, you must make sure that the Team Coach or Manager has an emergency contact number for you. Children under the age of 8 years **MUST NOT** be left.
- Rugby is a contact sport and whilst we take every care to minimise the risk of injury, injuries do occur. The club has the RFU Compulsory Insurance cover **BUT** we recommend that you take out your own individual, more comprehensive, insurance cover.

Complaints Procedure

KCRFC takes seriously any complaints raised by parents, supporters, visiting clubs or officials and members of the public.

In order that any complaint can be investigated and dealt with properly then KCRFC requires members and officials to follow the process below.

1) Any complaint must be raised with the relevant team manager or captain in the first instance and as soon as is practicable after the incident occurred. As much information as possible must be given to allow the Club to start its investigation and/or follow up.

.2) In the absence of a team manager or captain then the matter should be raised with either the Club Chairman or Mini Junior Chairman.

3) All serious complaints should be brought to the attention of the Club Chairman within 48hrs of being reported (or the Club Secretary in their absence).

4) The Club will ensure the matter is investigated thoroughly and will aim to respond to the relevant people within 7days.

5) No Club official shall raise a formal complaint against another Club or to a relevant authority without the permission of the Club Chairman (or Secretary in their absence).

6) No decision relating to a complaint that has a bearing on the reputation/ name of KCRFC or the relationship with another Club shall be made without it first being discussed by the Chairman, Mini Junior Chairman and Secretary, and if appropriate Club Executive Committee.

7) KCRFC would encourage all parents and guardians to involve KCRFC in the first instance if they are considering raising a complaint or reporting any incident that involved their child or persons in their care.
