Facility Improvements

Leicestershire and Rutland County Football Association have been working with Barwell Sports and Social Club and Barwell Football Club on their plans to redevelop their stadia grass pitch with a 3G Football Turf Pitch to meet the needs of the local football community. The project will not only provide a high-quality surface for the club to use for training and match play, but provide a much needed community facility for the Barwell and surrounding areas.

The project has been identified within the Local Football Facilities Plan which identified a shortfall of 5 pitches within the Borough of Hinckley and Bosworth. The pitch will not only support junior and senior football club provision but provide a venue for recreational activities through targeted programmes for women and girls, disability provision and health and well being provision. There will also be the opportunity to work with local schools and community groups to deliver activities at site.

Both during the project development and post build, Leicestershire and Rutland County FA will work with the clubs to ensure that the site is accessible to the local community, including monitoring the programme of use, pricing policy and management models for the site.

We are looking forward to working with the club on the successful development of new facilities in the Barwell area.
