Potton made an early exit from the Hinchingbrooke Cup losing 2-1 to United Counties Premier Division North side Pinchbeck United. In the main Potton were restricted to long shots and when they did get close range opportunities, they failed to take them. The winning goal cam from an unfortunate own goal deflection.

Potton started brightly with aaron McArdle shooting wide and then he played the ball back to David Etheridge who also shot wide. Viera dragged his shot wide when well placed and then Pinchbeck forced three corners un succession before Viera headed over. Danny Baulk was causing the Pinchbeck some trouble with his runs and he saw a header saved before going close on two occasions. Stafford then headed over from a corner. McArdle had to be substituted after pulling his hamstring again and this did not appear to affect Potton's attacking play with Baulk shooting over from distance and Cole Butlers effort going just wide. In the 44th minute Potton conceded a free kick on the edge of the penalty area and from the resulting kick Stafford was unmarked to put the ball past new keeper Lee Axworthy. In the dying minutes of the half Baulk shot over and then saw his shot well saved by the keeper.

Potton pressed early in the second half and from a long clearance from keeper Axworthy Baulk beat the Pinchbeck keeper to the ball and when faced with an empty net he shot wide. In the 50th minute a centre from Jack Thomas was headed home by Butler to equalise from a Jack Thomas centre Cole Butler headed home to equalise. Thomas saw his shot blocked and both keepers produced good saves when the rare shots were on target, Pinchbeck's from Thomas and Axworthy from shots from Foster and Williams. In the 70th minute Potton were on the attack when Pinchbeck made a quick break and from Williams low centre Lil Francisco diverted it his own net.
