



COVID-19 RELATED TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE SALE OF TICKETS

In accepting the terms and conditions for this ticket purchase you are confirming on behalf of any members of your party the following specific points in relation to the restrictions/requirements arising from the impact of the Covid-19:

- You agree to adhere to the social distancing arrangements put in place in the ground and whilst in and around the stadium you will maintain social distancing at all times, avoiding close contact with anyone not in your household or support bubble
- You acknowledge that due to Covid-19 restrictions that certain spectator services, such as snack bar/refreshments may be limited or not available at all. There may also be limited access/restrictions in relation to toilet facilities in the ground
- You confirm that any member of your party forming a household or support bubble, will not attend any matches if anyone shows Covid-19 symptoms in line with prevailing government guidance. At the present time guidance indicates the following have been identified as Covid-19 symptoms:
 - A high temperature (above 37.8 deg. C)
 - A new continuous cough
 - A loss of or change to their sense of smell or taste
- You agree to provide Boston United FC all required details in order for the club to comply with the NHS Track and Trace requirements for anyone attending on a matchday, or any other requirement introduced by the government.
- You agree to abide by the BUFC Covid-19 Spectator Code of behaviour (as below); the Boston United Spectator Behaviour Policy; the Ground Rules, and any instructions given by a club official

BUFC COVID-19 SPECTATOR CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

In order to assist our staff and stewards, and to help protect you and your fellow spectators, you are kindly requested to follow these guidelines:

- At all times and in all parts of the ground, please observe social distancing and avoid close contact with others not in your social or support bubble
- Arrive in good time to the ground to go through all the necessary entry procedures
- Make sure you know in advance where your entry point is, and if an entry time is specified on your ticket be there on time

- Be aware that we may require that all payments in the ground are contactless
- If you need to access any of the grounds amenities, such as toilets and food and drink outlets, check to see if any of them are not in use and plan accordingly.
- Remain in your seat or place whenever possible
- If you need to leave your viewing position, wait for a time when the gangway is clear and always follow the signage/steward indicating which way to go
- If you are in a seated area, when moving past other spectators, to and from your seat, please avoid face to face contact with other spectators
- If you are in a standing area, please stay within your social or support bubble and remain aware of the movements of others at all times
- Maintain good hand hygiene – use the sanitiser dispensers provided and avoid touching your face whenever possible
- Please observe respiratory etiquette – always cover your mouth if needing to cough or sneeze
- Avoid hugs, high-fives and any close contact with people who are not within your social or support bubble
- Take extreme care when shouting, singing or celebrating
- If you are attending with other members of your social or support bubble, please make sure they have read and understood these guidelines too
- Respond to any requests from a Club Official or Steward, which may include asking you to remain in your seat (or on the terrace) for a period at the end of match to enable safe egress from the stadium for all spectators
