Terms and Conditions of Membership

There are several points to consider before signing up for the forthcoming season, please read carefully.

Training & Matches

- ☒ Attendance is expected for all training sessions - please notify your child's coach/admin in case of absence.
- ☒ Appropriate clothing/kit/refreshment is required for all training and matches, based on the weather conditions and playing surface.
- ☒ Shin pads and appropriate footwear are always required, NO jewellery.
- ☒ Players must arrive punctually at the appropriate venue at training, or when selected for matches.
- ☒ The club does not provide transport to and from away fixtures
- ☒ The club is not a childcare service, players of primary school age MUST be accompanied to and from training and matches by a parent/guardian at all times unless otherwise agreed by the team manager/coach.
- ☒ Team selection is based on ABILITY, ATTITUDE and COMMITMENT. Players must respect the selection and decisions of the manager.

Data Protection

Please note, in accordance with General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR), the information provided in the registration document will be used to register your child with Portishead Town Junior Football Club on the Football Association's Whole Game System. This database is fully GDPR compliant and registration forms will be shredded as soon as the information has been entered. Essential medical information, including details of any medical condition and emergency contact details (first names and surname initial only and contact number), will be given to your child's football coach and kept safe in the team's medical kit.
