Old Leamingtonians inconsistency in their League matches has cost them dearly this season and once again far too many penalties were conceded and too often good possession kicked away allowing the visitors to claim advantage and demonstrate how to convert possession into points.

The game started with OLs playing against the wind and dominating the set pieces (even to the extent of winning scrummages against the head) but it was Rugby St Andrews that posted the first score with a simple penalty from in front of the posts after five minutes of play.

OLs responded with an equalising penalty within five minutes and following that spent long periods in the visitors territory but despite dominating the first half play it was the home side that fell behind when a loose kick out of defence was caught cleanly by a St Andrews three-quarter who ran for goal before releasing his winger on the overlap to run in a try behind the posts. The try was converted to give St Andrews a 10 point to 3 lead that they took into half time.

OLs began the second half with wind advantage and more pressure on the visitors but for all the effort put in the home side could not find a way through a well organised opposition. A second OLs converted penalty did reduce the lead but in spite of the wind advantage it always looked as if it was going to be St Andrews that added points through their penetrating attacking play and solid defence...





Three further second half tries, two of which were converted, gave St Andrews a four try bonus point and OLs must look back on this game and wonder what could have been.

The home forwards dominated but all too often the resulting good ball was kicked away in efforts to overcome the solid St Andrews defence. In the end OLs maintained their third place in the league but the gap between them and the top two increased having a marked effect on the promotion hopes.

Next week's game sees OLs visit Shipston on Stour RFC, a game that is now critical if OLs are to maintain any chance of league advancement. Kick off 2.15


