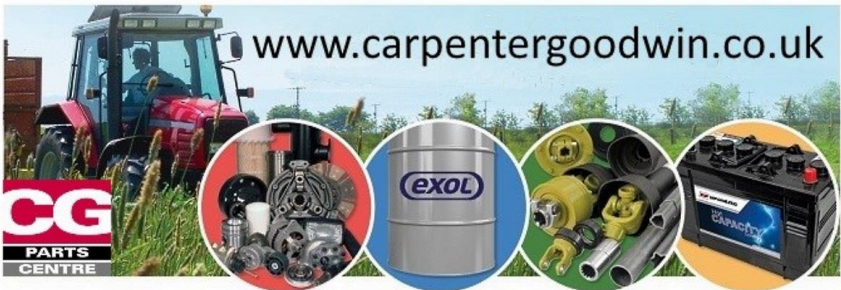


### **3rd XI friendly v Woolhope 2nds 19-07-2020**
