

This policy was adopted at the Betley FC AGM July 2012 and revised at the July 2017 AGM and applies to all Betley FC players engaged in team football.

The policy may be amended from time to time but only by agreement of the Management Committee (MC)

The principal objective of the policy is to have a uniformly distinctive kit across all age groups.

The club will be responsible for the procurement and provision of a basic playing kit consisting of socks shorts and shorts.

Individual teams may wish to augment their kit with additional items but such items are subject to MC approval which shall include issues around funding, sponsorship and ownership arrangements.

The club considers it appropriate that kit, especially in the youth teams, to be recycled as appropriate in order to maximise its useful life.

The current basic kit comprises of a scarlet shirt, black shorts and red socks. The preferred away kit shall be white or blue shirts.

All playing kit is to be purchased from Cheshire Workwear (unless approval is made by MC to purchase elsewhere) by a responsible person as appointed by the MC.

The club confirms its appreciation of initiatives, consistent with this policy, to secure sponsorship for the provision of kit which will remain the property of the club.
