# Notes to the Financial Statements for the Year Ended 30th April 2019

#### 1. STATUTORY INFORMATION

Lutterworth Rugby Football Club Limited is a society, limited by shares, registered in England and Wales. The society's registered number and registered office address can be found on the Society's Information page.

#### 2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of Section 1A "Small Entities" of Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" and the Co-operative & Community Benefit Societies Act 2014. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

#### Turnover

Turnover is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable, excluding discounts, rebates, value added tax and other sales taxes.

#### Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Ground equipment and fixtures
Other equipment and fixtures
Drainage project
-Straight line on cost over 4 years
-Straight line on cost over 20 years

#### **Stocks**

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items.

#### **Taxation**

Taxation for the year comprises current and deferred tax. Tax is recognised in the Income Statement, except to the extent that it relates to items recognised in other comprehensive income or directly in equity.

Current or deferred taxation assets and liabilities are not discounted.

Current tax is recognised at the amount of tax payable using the tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the balance sheet date.

#### **Deferred tax**

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Timing differences arise from the inclusion of income and expenses in tax assessments in periods different from those in which they are recognised in financial statements. Deferred tax is measured using tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the year end and that are expected to apply to the reversal of the timing difference.

Unrelieved tax losses and other deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that it is probable that they will be recovered against the reversal of deferred tax liabilities or other future taxable profits.

#### 3. EMPLOYEES AND DIRECTORS

The average number of employees during the year was 7 (2018 - 7).

# <u>Independent Chartered Accountants' Review Report to the Director of</u> <u>Lutterworth Rugby Football Club Limited</u>

We have performed certain procedures in respect of the society's unaudited financial statements for the year ended 30th April 2019 on pages three to eight, made enquiries of the committee members and assessed accounting policies adopted by the committee members, in order to gather sufficient evidence for our opinion in this report.

This report is made solely to the society's members, as a body, in accordance with the terms of our engagement letter dated 24th April 2019. It has been released to the committee on the basis that this report shall not be copied, referred to or disclosed, in whole (save for the society's' own internal purposes or as may be required by law or by a competent regulator) or in part, without our prior written consent. Our work has been undertaken so that we might state to the members those matters that we have agreed to state to them in this report and for no other purpose. To the fullest extent permitted by law, we do not accept or assume responsibility to anyone other than the society as a body and the society's committee for our work, for this report or the opinions we have formed.

#### Respective responsibilities

The society's officers are responsible those matters set out on page four and they consider that the society is exempt from the statutory requirement for an audit for the year.

Our responsibility is to form and express an independent opinion, based on procedures carried out by us.

#### **Basis of Opinion**

We conducted our engagement in accordance with the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England & Wales Interim Technical Release TECH 09/13AAF. Our work was based primarily upon enquiry, analytical procedures and assessing accounting policies in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015). If we considered it to be necessary, we also performed limited examination of evidence relevant to certain balances and disclosures in the financial statements where we became aware of matters that might indicate a risk of material misstatement in the financial statements.

The terms of our engagement exclude any requirement to carry out a comprehensive assessment of the risks of material misstatement, a consideration of fraud, laws, regulations or internal controls, and we have not done so. We are not required to, and we do not, express an audit opinion on these financial statements.

#### **Opinion**

In our opinion:

- a) The accounts, including the revenue account and balance sheet, are in agreement with the accounting records kept by the society under s75 of the Co-operative and Community Benefit Societies Act 2014;
- b) Having regard only to, and on the basis of, the information contained in those accounting records, the revenue account and balance sheet comply with the requirements of the Co-operative & Community Benefit Societies Act 2014; and
- c) For the preceding year of account, the financial criteria for the exercise of the power conferred by section 84 were met in relation to the year.
