The objects of the Club are:

- To maintain and develop the Ground at the Club address or such other location as the Committee may from time to time determine as the headquarters of the Club and as a venue for playing the game and conducting the other activities of the Club so as to provide the best possible facilities for Members and those visiting the ground.
- To strengthen the bonds between the Club and the local community in areas surrounding the Club.

The assets and income of the Club shall be applied solely in furtherance of the above-mentioned objects and no portion shall be distributed directly or indirectly to the members of the Club except as bona fide compensation for services rendered or expenses incurred on behalf of the club.

MOBILE AND ONLINE COMMUNICATION **WITH CHILDREN** – *RFU safeguarding guidelines*

When communicating by phone, Club Officials and coaches should always speak to the parent or guardian of a child.

Club Officials and coaches should not communicate with individual children by text or on-line at any time, on any matter, unless there is an immediate risk to the welfare of that child which can be lessened by such contact.

If a club needs to communicate club-related information to children by email (training or match details), it should use email groups comprising email addresses given by parents. It is inadvisable for a

coach to communicate by email on a one-to-one basis with a child; if replying to an email from a child the parent should be copied in to the response.

Coaches and Club Officials should not communicate with children through social networking sites such as Facebook. Coaches should not be friends with the children they coach.

SOCIAL MEDIA & FOOTAGE

The Club can be vicariously (i.e. the Club didn't publish it) liable for material published by Club Members and employees, for example on an official website, social media site or feed, or published by employees outside work via a work email address or a work Twitter handle.

The Club can also be liable for third party comments and postings made in their website or social media forums or pages.

The Club therefore recommends;

- Any publicity whatsoever is generated in line with the RFU's Core Values and clearly identifies who posted the information
- All site administrators or moderators are clearly identified and part of their role will be to monitor output, moderate content and remove offensive postings

The Club will hold Members to account for breaches of the above.

DISCIPLINE

Leicestershire Rugby Union will deal firmly with cases brought before them of indiscipline **both on and off the field**.

All parties attending games can be and will be held accountable including;

- Spectators and parents with regard to their behaviour towards the referee and players.
- Club members and players with regard to their behaviour towards the referee and opposition.

The RFU minimum sanctions for threatening actions or words towards match officials are a ban of 12 weeks and physical abuse of match officials 24 weeks.

In instances where the behaviour or actions of spectators or parents may be deemed outside the domain of the RFU Disciplinary Regulations, the RFU reserve the right to and will impose sanctions against the club directly.

RFU rule 5.12 refers to “Actions prejudicial to the interests of the Union and the Game”. In law the club is jointly responsible for the actions of all its members. Sanctions imposed under this rule have included deduction of senior team league points and substantial fines.

Lutterworth RFC supports the action of Leicestershire Rugby Union in upholding one of the key Core Values of the game and reminds its Members that embracing these values is to the benefit of us all.

Any player red carded must not play until their disciplinary hearing has been held by Leics RU.

Administration costs incurred by the Club will be passed onto the offending Club member or player.

CLUB CONCUSSION PROTOCOL

In the event of a player receiving a blow to the head such that sufficient concern is raised for the game to be stopped and/or the first aider attends the player the player must be removed from the field for an assessment.

Note for First Aiders: *Your knowledge of the player is important as the assessment should not be restricted to the one incident. Repeated blows to the head (including previous games) need to be taken into account.*

The first aider will assess the player for concussion (and/or repeated blows) and a decision made at the end of 10 minutes whether the player may return to the game or not. Should the First Aider believe that the blow suffered is such that concussion has or is likely to have occurred (or that the matter is one of repeated blows) the player must take no further part in the game.

The first aider must; Inform the player that he/she is to be treated under the RFU guidelines for concussion; Give the player a copy of the handout outlining the procedure to be followed; Advise the player to take medical advice in the event of a deterioration or if within 24 hours there has been no improvement in the health of the player, make an appropriate entry into the Injury Book; Inform the player's Team Manager of the incident and that the player must not be considered for selection for 19 days (adult) 23 days (Junior) after the date of the incident and incorporating the terms of a Graduated Return to Play (GRTP). Team Managers up to and including U18 are responsible for...

...informing the player's parent. The parent should also inform the player's school.

Should the player dispute the presence of concussion (or the effect of repeated blows) the player has the right to take independent medical advice from a doctor and submit the relevant evidence to the Team Manager. No player shall return to play until a doctor has determined that the player is fit to do so and that such finding has been communicated to the Team Manager. It is the parent's responsibility to obtain the clearance for players under 18yrs. It is the player's responsibility for aged 18yrs or above.

CLUB DRUGS POLICY

Any person found in possession of, using or distributing illicit drugs on Lutterworth RFC premises will be banned from the premises, reported to the police and their Club membership will be terminated.

RFU ILLICIT DRUGS POLICY

The RFU Illicit Drugs Policy applies to all players and all clubs. Each player and club must observe and comply by this policy. Participants in the game alleged to have committed or contributed to a breach of this Policy may be subject to investigation and sanction under RFU Rule 5.12 Misconduct.

DOGS ON THE PREMISES

Lutterworth RFC welcomes dogs and careful dog owners. All members, supporters and visitors have a duty of care to those of all ages that play, love our game and provide so much pleasure to those that spectate.

Hence;

- Dogs must be kept under control and on a lead outside the clubhouse at all times
- Dogs are NOT permitted on any pitch or playing area at any time including the youth pitch areas. This includes the area along a full sized pitch half way line when it has been divided into two youth pitches
- If your dog makes a mess anywhere on club premises (inside or out) clean it up immediately
- If you see a dog leaving mess, tell the owner. If they don't clean it up, ask them for their name and tell a Committee Member

DATA PROTECTION

Lutterworth Rugby Football Club is registered with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO): Registered Number ZA553429.

The Club require to process membership information to establish and maintain membership administration. This information will be processed as part of the Club's contractual basis with Club Members and will be retained for the period of time that membership continues.
