SUMMARY OF ROLE:

We currently have an opportunity for a Kit Manager within our 1st Team Set-up. This role may suit someone looking to break into the football set-up or alternatively someone who is looking to move up the pyramid.

In liaison with the staff, the kit manager will be responsible for ensuring that the coaches have all the required resources for days/evening training sessions as well as ensuring all teams have sufficient kit on matchdays.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Liaise with the club on all matters concerning kit and equipment requirements
- Ensure all the requirements for players and coaches are met
- Prepare and pack all match kit requirements and liaise with the coaching staff where necessary.
- Check all the kit back in after usage and liaise with Laundry staff to ensure kit is promptly cleaned and packed away safely and securely.
- Ordering, storing and distributing kit and equipment as directed
- Contribute to maintenance of the inventory of all kit and equipment
- To prepare all training kits
- To oversee the match kit; to prepare the kit allocation and check before and after fixtures.
- Maintain accurate records of all kit logs and report discrepancies
- To prepare training equipment for all training sessions
- To assist with the management of all kit and equipment storage spaces at Movie Starr Stadium, ensuring that they are organized to a professional standard.
- To assist with matchday operations
- Travel required for match days; this requirement means the role consists of working unsociable hours including evenings and most weekends.
