#### Treasurer's Report

#### For the year ended 30<sup>th</sup> September 2018

Attached are the <u>MANAGEMENT ACCOUNTS</u> of Beckenham Sports Club for the year to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2019

These accounts show a surplus for the year of £18843 (2018 a deficit of £12831) before transfers to the tennis and hockey Sinking Funds

During the year the Club has undertaken several maintenance projects which were in urgent need: -

- Ladies toilets (£6350)
- Electrical upgrade in Tennis Pavilion (£12250) More works on electrics are pending

AND GLASS BACKED SQUASH COURTS AND VIEWING GALLERY for a total cost of £85972

Thank you to the Squash Section members for their generous donations of £22200 (including Gift Aid) towards this project

The Squash Section has also secured sponsorship for this project of £20000 from Direct Security over a twelve-month period

As you are probably already aware there is also an ongoing project to relay the cricket square. This will be over a two-year period at a cost of approximately £68000. An interest free loan from the ECB for £50000 has been secured towards the cost of this project repayable over 5 years. This will appear in the 2020 accounts

Once the Cricket Square has been re-laid all sections of the Club will have the most up to date playing surfaces available to them so now it is time to upgrade the infrastructure of the Club

If funds are available the intention is to re-glaze the Bar and Long Room windows, extend the Long Room and build a Gym which is continuing to be discussed (See Chair's Report)

As stated in the previous year your particular attention is guided towards

- Note 5 Loans. The Club had £90,300 of loans at the Balance Sheet date which will need to be repaid over the next 8 years. £27,754 being repayable within the next 12 months
- Note 16 Capital Commitments. In addition to the above the Club has obligations attaching to the receipt of the LTA loans and the Hockey Astroturf pitch agreements.

Sinking Funds are required to be raised of £16,000 and £10,000 respectively every year to provide for future improvements/resurfacing costs

• There is also the ECB Loan of £50,000 to repay over the next 5 years not included in these accounts

Again repeating last year, the Club will need to raise these additional funds from members by increased membership and subscription income, from coaching fees and social activities in order to service the existing loans and achieve any improvement in facilities

I would like to thank all the Ground, Office and Bar staff for their unfailing loyalty and commitment to the Club and voluntary committee members for their hard work over the year.

Now that we are staffed by professionals and have a new Board of Directors we should see more improvements in the years to come

## Beckenham Sports Club Notes to the accounts

## 1. Accounting policies

#### Turnover

Turnover represents the following receipts during the year: -

- a) The net receipts in respect of the sale of drink, bar snacks and food, net of VAT and discounts, received during the year
- b) The amount received in respect of subscriptions for membership of each playing section of the Club
- c) The amount received in respect of Court, coaching and match fees, sponsorship and venue hire

#### **Depreciation (See note 2)**

Depreciation is charged so as to write off the cost of tangible fixed assets over their estimated useful lives to the Club on the following bases: -

Plant & Equipment, Bar & Kitchen Equipment, furniture & fittings on a straight-line basis over 5 years

TV and electrical equipment on a straight-line basis over 3 years

Steel storage containers on a straight-line basis over 10 years

No depreciation is charged on the Pavilion and Groundsman's House as these are considered to be appreciating assets

### Amortisation (See note 3)

Amortisation is calculated so as to write off the cost of permanent playing facilities and their respective deferred funding on a straight-line basis as follows: -

Cricket nets on a straight-line basis over 10 years

2011 Clay Tennis Courts on a straight-line basis over 11 years

Hockey Astroturf Pitch on a straight-line basis over 12 years

2017 Clay Tennis Courts on a straight-line basis over 10 years

No amortisation has been charged on the Glass Backed Squash Courts or viewing gallery as they were only officially opened in October 2019

#### 16. Capital Commitments

#### Astroturf Pitch

The Club has an obligation under the terms of the Astroturf Pitch agreement with Langley Park School for Girls to provide £10000 per annum into a Sinking Fund for the purpose of re-surfacing the Astroturf pitch in 2029. This represents 50% of the total anticipated cost of resurfacing

#### 2017 Clay Tennis Courts

The Club has an obligation under the terms of the LTA Loan agreement to provide £16000 per annum over the term of the loan agreement into a Sinking Fund for the purpose of future re-surfacing costs

#### 2020 Cricket Square

The Club has committed to re-lay the cricket square for a cost of £68000 over the next two years. An interest free loan has been obtained from the English Cricket Board for £50000 towards this project which is repayable over 5 years

#### 17.Beckenham Proprietary Limited

- a) Issued share capital 840 shares of £5 each. Of the 840 shares held, 159 were donated to the club and 681 shares were purchased at £5 per share plus expenses.
- b) The company owns the freehold of the ground, which is leased to Beckenham Sports Club ("the Club") for a 99-year term ending 28 September 2035. The company has waived until further notice the rent stipulated in that lease.
- c) The company has charged to the National Westminster Bank Plc the whole of its property as security for its guarantee of any amounts owing to the bank by the Club up to a maximum amount of £25,000. At 30 September 2018, the amount guaranteed was £Nil.
- d) The directors of Beckenham Proprietary Limited hold a copy of the company's directors' report and financial statements for the year ended 30 September 2019
