**Good afternoon everyone, and for our second successive home League game of the 2013/14 season we welcome the players, officials and supporters from South Kilburn, also a welcome to the three match officials for today's match.**

Both of today's teams got off to a winning start to the new season last Saturday, South Kilburn 3-1 away to Epsom Athletic, and Knaphill's 4-1 success at Farleigh.

Knaphill launched the 2013/14 season in the win away at Farleigh Rovers with goals from Danny Hartlebury (2) Matt Powell and Phil Ruggles. Three days later Dorking were the visitors to Redding Way for our first home league game. The outcome was another three points from a match that saw Knaphill take a first half lead through Danny Hartlebury after 29 minutes. Dorking pulled themselves back in to the game with two goals in the space of eleven minutes in the second half, but Knaphill battled back when Dan Thorogood equalised in the 74th minute.

Then came a spell where either side could have snatched a late winner, but the crucial third goal and maximum points was clinched by Knaphill as the home side surged forward, saw two goal attempts blocked before Matt Powell found the space between keeper and the post to slot home the winner two minutes into stoppage time. What a finish! Although there were only three Division One games on the night, Knaphill's result put them top of the table, a place they will be seeking to keep in today's encounter against South Kilburn. You can read the Match report elsewhere in the Programme.

Knaphill are obviously looking for a big improvement in results from last season when there were changes in Management and

players as the team finished in twelve in the table. Although no honours gained as far as Cup or trophies were concerned on the field, Knaphill gained an award off the pitch, winning the Combined Counties League Division One Programme of the Year award, the third time in six seasons. Our Reserves were given an honourable mention for being Runners Up in the Fair Play Award in the Reserves Division.

However, new challenges are now on the horizon with Management and players for the 2013/14 season. Phil Ruggles has started his first full season as first team manager, with Steve Pearman as his Assistant, and Keith Hills and Roland Baker in the Coaching capacity. Trevor Smith is the Club's new Physio. We started our first game against Farleigh with several new signings making their Club debuts, including Lee Allen, Ben Acton, Ian Messenger, Matt Powell, Danny Hartlebury, Dan Thorogood, Craig Prendergast and Max Galbraith. Last season's captain Jamie Doble, was one of just a few players remaining from last season, and Jamie continues this season as skipper. Dave Kelly continues in that role for 2013/14 season, with the team playing in new Central Division of the Suburban League, and has Lee Mason with him as Assistant Manager.

Our Reserves kick off their new season in the Central Division of the Suburban League with a home fixture against North Greenford next Saturday 17th August. The Reserves Division

of the Combined Counties has had to disband due to lack of teams in that Division, with several Clubs from last season moving into the Suburban League, and three into the Surrey Elite League. The Youth U18s team, who have had some impressive performances from their pre-season friendlies, including wins against Molesey 6-1, Walton & Hersham 7-1, and a hard fought 2-2 draw against Met.Police U18s, kick off their second season in the Southern Youth League on the 26th August. Knaphill Ladies team commence their Greater London Womens Football League season on the second weekend in September, and will again be competing in the Women's FA Cup.

We welcome a new sponsor to the Club, Cellar Magneval who have kindly sponsored our main sign at the entrance to the Club. Commercial and Marketing Manager Lisa Harding said "As a family and Community Club, we are always excited when local businesses partner with us so that we can take the Club forward".

Back to this afternoon's game, and one where we hope to enhance on our opening two wins of the season against Farleigh and Dorking. Next Saturday 17th August Knaphill are away to CB Hounslow United kick off 3pm, then we have two home League matches in succession. Sheerwater

will be the visitors for the local derby game on Saturday 24th August, which is also part of Knaphill's Community Day here at Redding Way. Then on Saturday 31st August we are scheduled to be home to Staines Lammas, providing our visitors are not engaged in Cup competition.

# REPORTING BACK

## Combined Counties League Division 1, Tuesday 6th August Knaphill 3 - 2 Dorking FC

Following their win at Farleigh in the opening game of the season, Knaphill gained another three points in Tuesday's 3-2 success against Dorking at Redding Way. What an end to the game though, with the score at 2-2, it was Knaphill who made a smash and grab three points in a frenetic finish when two minutes into stoppage time, Matt Powell slotted home the winner to the mass delight of his team mates.



The game opened at a fast pace, but with twenty minutes played in the first half, not one direct effort on goal from either side. Plenty of build ups, no end product. But then Dan Thorogood delivered Knaphill's first shot which went over the bar, and shortly after, Knaphill keeper Lee Allen was to deny Dorking with a fine save from the oncoming Richard Wetton.

The deadlock was prised open in the 29th minute when the visitors defence was stretched allowing Danny Hartlebury to cut into the box and deliver an excellent strike high into the roof of the net to give Knaphill the lead. After the goal, the home side had two further efforts blocked, and at the other end, Allen was forced into denying Dorking again. Liam Pearson's long shot effort went just wide of the post as Knaphill held onto their slender one goal lead at halftime.

Knaphill went close in the first five minutes of the second half when Pearson was unlucky to see his shot come back off the post. Hartlebury had his effort for the home side saved by the keeper on 55 minutes, but after 58 minutes the home defence conceded a rather sloppy goal which allowed Dorking the equaliser. The visitors were boosted by this and put on some pressure, looking for a second goal, which eventually saw them take the lead in the 69th minute through James Page.

Dorking's lead only lasted for five minutes as Knaphill battled back to equalise in the 74th minute when Dan Thorogood fired into the far corner of goal to make 2-2. The last fifteen minutes became tense, and both sides had chances to score a third, but the final bit of pressure came from Knaphill to create a dramatic finish. Just two minutes into added time and a crowded Dorking goalmouth, two Knaphill efforts were partially cleared, the ball came to Matt Powell who slotted home the winner between the keeper and his near post. A grand finish!

# PAYING US A VISIT... SOUTH KILBURN FC

Knaphill FC would like to extend a warm welcome to South Kilburn FC, their Management and Fans - Welcome to Redding Way.

Formed in 2005, South Kilburn FC. Joined the Middlesex County Football League in season 2005-2006. Despite finishing third from bottom in The Cherry Red Books MCFL Division One.

The inaugural season was a learning curve for the newly formed team. The disappointing league position did however, provide a sound base for the club to develop from and set the stage for progression. With a considerable amount of endeavour on and off the pitch, South Kilburn made great strides forward in season 2006-2007 using only four games

All Season, the club finished top of MCFL Division One and had good cup runs in a number of county cups. The success of 2006-2007 was replicated in 2007-2008 as the club exceeded its own high expectations in finishing second in the Cherry Red Books MCF Premier Division. The league success was supported by two good cup runs as south Kilburn reached the semi-final of The Alec Smith Premier Division Cup and narrowly lost 2-1 in the final of the London County FA junior Cup.

The runners up league position allowed South Kilburn to make the jump up to the Hellenic League and step 6 in the non-league football pyramid in their first season at that level and South Kilburn finished a very respectable sixth in the league. After a successful stint at Broadfields County Club, South Kilburn moved grounds to Vale Farm Sports Centre in Wembley in August 2009. Extensive work to meet the ground grading requirements has taken place at the ground throughout the last year and the club now look forward to welcoming all of this season opponents back to Vale Farm.

Despite a strong start to last season and a promising run in the London Senior Cup, South Kilburn were ultimately left to rue missed chances as a succession of draws and defeats left them 5th in the table and thinking what might have been. South Kilburn will certainly be looking to improve on that 5th place in season 2010-2011. In season 2010-2011 we had a very poor season but we still stayed at step six in the Hellenic Football League and we had three great seasons with them. We made more improvements to our ground this season and are making more as we go along. We moved across to the Combined Counties Football League with the FA's permission for season 2011-2012 so we hope to carry on with our plans with the ground and players and hope to have a good season. We have had a hard season we finished 14th in the league we had some good games and some bad games. Season 2012 -2013 we had a much better season we finished 5th we had some really good games this year. Players gelled with each other and we hope to do more with the ground next season.

# YOUNG GUNS

Nick's Notes from the Southern Youth League.....



The Southern Youth League's season doesn't start for another 3 weeks, but now is a good time to look forward to see how the Young Knappers are shaping up for the upcoming campaign. Manager Gary Taylor has been working hard to attract talented youngsters to the Knaphill cause. He has also retained the experienced former semi-pro Mark Dawber as Assistant Manager and highly rated young coach Alex Lumley. The pleasing part of last season was to see so many youngsters make their senior debuts for the Firsts & Reserves, as well as U18 captain Jonny Coats securing the SYL Player of the Season award along with the Club's Player's Player award.

Pre-season friendlies have seen convincing wins against Westside (5-1), long time rivals Molesey (6-1) and Walton & Hershaw (7-1) and a hard fought 2-2 with the highly rated Metropolitan Police U18's. Monday night's 0-7 defeat by a strong Ascot United was played with a mixture of 1st year (15 yrs old boys) and some triallists. With a final friendly at Bedfont Sports still to come, the youngster should hit the ground running looking to start the season on a winning note and the prize of a first time 1st Qualifying Round FA Youth Cup away tie against either Sussex side Lancing or long time rivals Molesey. Gary also took along young sides (U16's) to the Molesey & Meadow Sports Tournaments this summer and walked away with the titles at both.

There are old faces from last year such as striker Tony Kozakis who has scored 5 goals in pre-season and Knaphill's Golden Boot Winner from last year Mekhaill McLaughlin who has scored 4 pre-season. Nico Aquino, Cameron Bose, Alfie Fairhall, Robert Litchfield & Scott James have all played parts of varying degrees last season and will this year all play significant roles with the team.

New faces to look for include two new keepers, Alex Kozakis (Tony's younger brother) and Fraser McCambridge-Heal who are both 16 years old. Other new names include Louis Ali, Charlie

Brace, Max Carey, Oliver Hudson, Rhys King, Ben Littlemore, Bradley Mulhall, Dan Qureshi & Nathan Williams. There are a few old faces still to make their decisions as to where they will be playing this season and Gary hopes to have these players signed up shortly.
