

This afternoon is the beginning of another nine months of League and Cup football, and welcome everyone to Redding Way today for Knaphill's opening game of the season against Eversley & California. The close season has produced a lot of activity within Knaphill Football Club, which has included work by our Club officials, decorating the clubhouse, dressing room facilities and other areas, as well as doing essential work around the ground. A great deal of time and effort has gone into the work by the Club during June and July. There has also been some work done on the pitch, slitting, top soiling etc, although it was started later than expected into the close season. Unlike other work in and around the ground, I hasten to add this was not done by club officials!

The players were back in action when they started training on 21st June, which has led to the build up to the new season with pre-season friendlies against Badshot Lea, Camberley Town, Raynes Park Vale, Chertsey Town and Egham Town. When Manager Phil Ellery joined us back in October 2011, his aim from then on was to rebuild a side, which had seen several players depart from the Club, and to finish in a respectable position in Division One, where the team finally finished in 11th place.

But Phil then put the big challenge of looking ahead to get season 2012/13 off to a good start with the ultimate aim of working towards promotion to the Premier Division. Phil has Paul Thornton as his Assistant Manager for the new season, whilst newcomer Simon Hickson is Head Coach, with Tom Davis continuing in his role as Assistant 1st team coach, and Matt Edwards, goalkeeper coach. For the Reserve side, we welcome Paul Dyer to the Club as the Reserves new Manager alongwith with his assistant Kevin Arnold. Paul comes to Redding Way with a wealth of experience in management.

Phil Ellery has made a number of new signings over the past few weeks, which have included Matt Nash, Jamie Redrup, James Dart, Ray Randall, Dominic Worthington, Darren Varney, Liam Parrington, and Charles Postance, to name but a few whilst defender Danny Cox makes his return to Redding Way having missed a season and a half through injury. The team face 34 games in Division One which sees two new clubs this season, Epsom Athletic and AFC Croydon Athletic.

The Cup draws made for the season sees Knaphill having a bye in the first round of both Premier Challenge Cup and Division One Challenge Cup. Knaphill are home to Westfield in round two of the Division 1 Cup on Tuesday 2nd October, and in the Premier Challenge Cup, also have a home tie in round two against Mole Valley, date to be announced.

In the 1st Qualifying round of the FA Vase, Knaphill visit Premier club Ash United, and have been drawn away to Farleigh Rovers in the Surrey Premier Cup, but the tie is likely to be played at Redding Way as our opponents don't have floodlights, and all ties are normally played in midweek. In the Southern Combination Cup, Knaphill will play hosts to Cove.

Our Reserves don't kick off their season until Saturday 18th August, the Youth U18s start by the end of the month, whilst the two Ladies teams kick-off in their respective Leagues during September.

On the sponsorship side, the club have Intecsea continuing as the main sponsor, and other sponsors and partners include Alpha Hospital, Affordable Rentals, Kevin Putley Garden Services, Lansbury Business Estate, Wickes DIY, and PRS Distribution. So the challenge starts from today, in which we hope Knaphill will become one of the front runners in the league campaign, whilst also looking to progress in the FA Vase and other cup competitions in season 2012/13. Our second game of the season is here at Redding Way against South Kilburn next Saturday 11thAugust kick off 3pm.

EVERSLEY & CALIFORNIA FC




The Club has come a very long way in a short space of time and has enjoyed a tremendous amount of success over the years. After spending the majority of seasons playing in the Aldershot & District League, the 1st team and Reserves eventually progressed to the Surrey County Intermediate League Western in 2005. It continued to aim high and has always showed great ambition which resulted in a successful application to join the Surrey Elite Intermediate League in 2008 for its inaugural season. Under the control of a new management team the 1st team went on to win an unforgettable League and Cup double and in the same season the Reserves narrowly missed out on first place in the League after only losing once all season, but success for them came with a double Cup triumph. These achievements in the 2008/09 season enabled us to gain promotion to the Combined Counties League Division One and be part of the National Football League System for the first time in our history. This was a fabulous accomplishment for a small village club, but is certainly just reward for all the hard work and effort which has gone on over the years behind the scenes by the various people involved.

Prior to 2009 the club had never really had a ground or a pitch that it could call its true 'home' and had spent the previous 8-9 years moving between various local authority owned pitches located away from the village. In 2002 the club joined forces with California FC and Eversley Cricket Club to form the Eversley Sports Association (ESA). The aim of the ESA was to plan and implement the development of 15 acres of land leased from RMC Aggregates (now Cemex), to construct superior sports facilities and provide common services for the three participating clubs. In 2006 the ESA were successful in gaining the largest ever grant from the Football Foundation for a Hampshire based project.

It seemed like a long time coming but the new ground and facilities were finally completed and opened in July 2009. The many years of hard work and effort have really been worthwhile and we are incredibly grateful to the ESA committee for all the time they have spent, and continue to spend, on this community project. We now have a recognised ground to call 'home' with fantastic modern facilities. We regularly receive many compliments from opposing teams, match officials and supporters in respect of our playing surface and facilities, and formal accolade came in 2010 when we were then nominated for 'FA Ground of the Year' for Steps 5 and 6. In 2012 our hard working groundsman won the Combined Counties League 'Groundsman of the Year' award.

Despite our long history our biggest success has come in recent years and we are working hard to make sure that this continues. By striving to perform to the highest standards on and off the pitch our ambitions and aspirations are something we hope will make the village of Eversley proud of.


