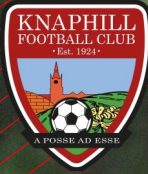

After testing times of late for the club and everyone involved with Knaphill FC I am convinced things will turn for the better .

After the departure of manager Liam Parrington i would like to say a few words about the situation.

Liam and myself took charge in summer and I was certain we would move the club forward. With all the changes in personnel on and off the pitch this task was a lot harder then expected.

Unfortunately Liam and the club decided to part company after thirteen games. Not great to here the news but I was determined to help change the fortunes on the pitch.

Liam will be back in football soon and I will back him in any path he chooses to take . Liam is an outstanding coach and football man who I hold in high regard. I wish him all the best.

After Liam's departure the club asked me to take charge of our home game against Ash Utd and the tough away fixture to Camberley Town.

My first game in charge was the home fixture in the cup against Ash, If I'm honest the situation with Liam moving on was a unhealthy distraction that night. A lot of the players where asking questions and a little confused about the whole situation, however we had a job to do.

After the Ash game in the week I was not going to set the team up in the same way, we where far to open and easy to get at. With a change in formation and simple instructions about defending in numbers and being difficult to beat we pulled one out the bag that day.

They adapted excellently to the formation and looked far more solid from back to front. Credit to some of senior players in the team to who had also asked could we change formation in the week at training.

With us being harder to beat it was important we took our chances at the other end and we did. Harry Rapley scoring first from a Josh Barry cross and two minutes later exactly same the thing happened and Nathan Thomas was there to put us 2-0 up at half time.

In recent games we have allowed teams a life line and come away with nothing but there was a good togetherness among the players at half time and they came out for the second half and do the business.

Defending in numbers and looking to take the sting out of Camberley's play at any opportunity. We eventually got the clubs first win at Krooner Park with a clean sheet as an added bonus.
