COVID-19 RISK ASSESSMENT

Scenario 1 - Away Fixture - General

- All players and management will be listed (with contact numbers) and a copy provided to the opposition prior to the match.
- The players and management will be cross-checked against those entering the host club facility. No other personnel will be allowed to enter.
- All players and management must travel to the match in separate private vehicles, or via public transport observing current Government advice on social distancing, face protection etc.
- All players and officials shall change into kit observing current Government advice on social distancing. This is likely to involve changing outdoors (eg. in gazebos or whatever the host club provides), or in private vehicles, or in changing rooms if in restricted numbers of 5 or less.
- Any kit or equipment used in warm-ups to be collected by a nominated member of management wearing appropriate PPE such as face mark and disposable gloves.
- The match will be played in front of spectators conforming with current Government advice relative to the 3 Tier System and Local Authority guidance.
- No handshakes will take place with opposition players, management or the match officials.
- Medical personnel entering the field of play will wear appropriate PPE.
- Players will not be permitted to shower after the game at the host club venue.
- Used kit will be collected by a nominated member of management wearing appropriate PPE such as face mask and disposable gloves.
- Used kit and equipment will be laundered and sanitised before re-use by a nominated member of management wearing appropriate PPE.





<u>Scenario 2 – Home Fixture - General</u>

- This applies to games played at both the Marley Stadium and Summerhill Lane venues.
- All players and management will be listed (with contact numbers) and a copy provided to the opposition prior to the match.
- Opposition players and management will be cross-checked against those entering the premises, no other personnel will be allowed to enter.
- All players and management must travel to the match in separate private vehicles, or via public transport observing current Government advice on social distancing, face protection etc.
- All players and officials shall change into kit observing current Government advice on social distancing. This is likely to involve changing outdoors (eg. in gazebos or whatever the host club provides), or in private vehicles, or in changing rooms if in restricted numbers of 5 or less.
- Should players under the age of 18 be involved they may use the club changing room in groups of no more than 5 at a time. The changing room will be thoroughly cleaned after use.
- Should a female referee or assistant referee be involved they will be allowed to use the Officials Room to change. This room will be thoroughly cleaned after use.
- Any kit or equipment used in warm-ups to be collected by a nominated member of management wearing appropriate PPE such as face mark and disposable gloves.
- The match will be played behind closed doors.
- No handshakes will take place with opposition players, management or referees.
- Medical personnel entering the field of play will wear appropriate PPE.
- Players will not be permitted to shower after the game at the venue.
- Used kit will be collected by a nominated member of management wearing appropriate PPE such as face mask and disposable gloves. This kit will be laundered and sanitised before re-use by a nominated member of management wearing appropriate PPE.





<u>Scenario 3 – Home/Away Fixture – Competition Specific</u>

Steeton teams are likely to appear in these competitions during the 2020/21 season;

- North West Counties League (or any of its Cup tournaments)
- Yorkshire Amateur League (or any of its Cup tournaments)
- FA Vase
- West Riding County Cup
- West Riding County Challenge Cup

Should any of these competitions impose specific rules concerning COVID, in variance with Scenario 1 or Scenario 2, then the relevant team will comply with the specific rules of that competition.
